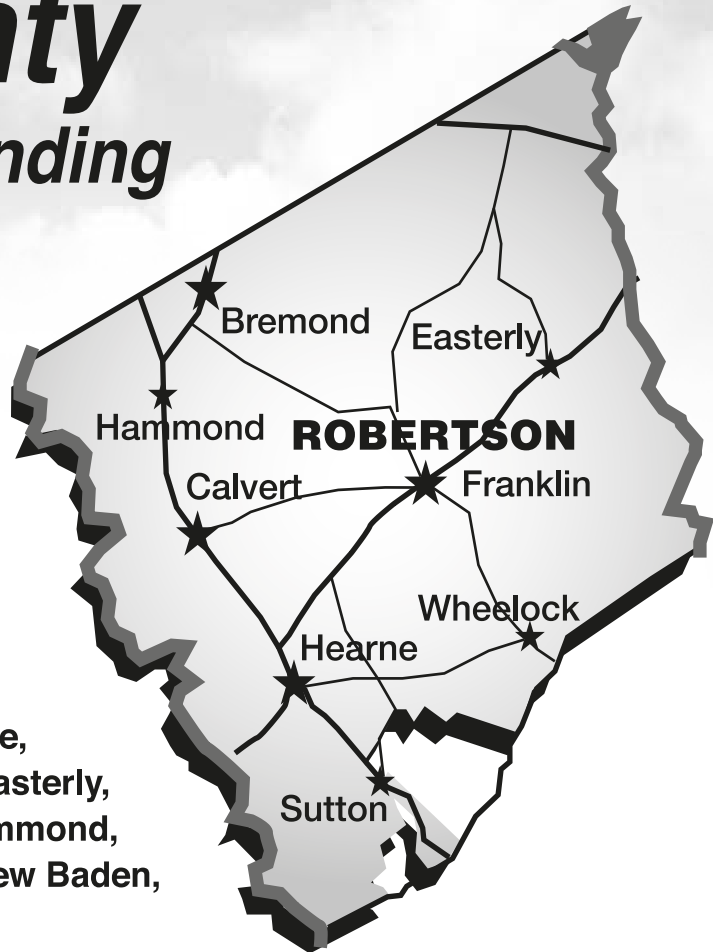

**Franklin**, the county seat of Robertson County since 1879, lies near the geographic center of the county, on an upland prairie that is drained by the branches of three creeks. Touchstone Branch, to the north, runs westward into Mud Creek; South Mineral Creek drains waters eastward to the Navasota River; and the forks of Cedar Creek run to the south.

residents. Through the time from 1870 until 1879, many of the people in Robertson County complained about the location of the county seat at Calvert. Several-times efforts were made to remove it but all failed until, in December 1879, a majority of the votes decreed that Morgan should replace Calvert and the town thereby became the new county seat.

Franklin came into existence in 1880; however, there was a small town, Morgan, at its present location a decade before. The history of the community is interwoven in the story of early settlement in the Robertson Colony and there are residents of the town who trace their ancestry to families that came to the area before the Texas Revolution.

When the results of the removal election were made public, families began moving to Morgan. On January 1, 1880, the Texas Land Company had over a hundred applications for property in the area.

Like the accounts of other places, the history of Franklin starts with the first ownership of land in the area of its general location. Huge sections of the land southeast of Franklin were originally granted to Jose Maria Viesca, a former Governor of the State of Coahuila and Texas. After 1836, Edward McMillan moved to a section west of present Franklin and Francis Slauter, the first to own the land on which Franklin is built, was the leading citizen of the area after the Revolution.

Franklin received its name in 1880, when commissioners learned there was another Texas town by the name of Morgan. The remedy was simple; Judge T. J. Simmons decreed that since the original county seat had been named "Franklin" to honor Francis Slauter, and since the new town was to be on land owned by that distinguished man of the early days of settlement, so should the new town honor him.

In 1872, the International Railway Company completed a segment of its lines between Hearne and the Navasota River and a number of villages developed along its right-of-way. One such village was Morgan, named for a railway official, Morgan lay on the present site of Franklin.

The Franklin area continues to experience significant growth. A new 84 acre park, & athletic complex were completed in the fall of 2012. The park includes baseball & softball fields for Little League & tournament play, football fields for Pop Warner Football League play, restrooms, concessions, playgrounds, walking trails & pavilions for community & family events.

The railroad changed rural living in many ways. In a short time there were sixty families living in Morgan. Morgan was a railroad town and its residents were railroad workers and farmers. There was a depot, water station, a platform for split and cut logs that supplied fuel for the train, and there were three small stores.

The city of Franklin is working to develop a 44-acre Industrial park which has access to US Highway 79 & the Union Pacific Railroad. A 4,500 square foot medical clinic was completed in Spring 2012, & the historic County Courthouse & jail are currently being renovated. Other examples of recent expansion in the area are:

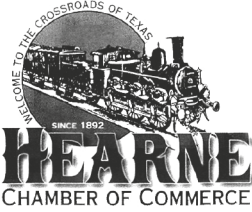
In that time, the Texas Land Company owned much of the land along the International lines. Their officials had made many surveys, and when it was determined that the place was near the geographic center of the county, several families moved to the area to build homes. Between 1872 and 1879, the population of the village increased to approximately two hundred

*Hearne, a people friendly town of 4,690, is in Robertson County. It is conveniently located in central Texas in the middle of a triangle formed by Dallas/Fort Worth, Houston, & San Antonio. Only 18-25 miles from Bryan/College Station and Texas A&M University, Hearne offers visitors & residents alike an opportunity to escape the hustle & bustle of the big city to enjoy Hearne's peaceful, small town charm.*

*Known as "The Crossroads Of Texas," Hearne is nestled at the crossroads of three major highways as well as two major Union Pacific Railroad lines. Highways TX 6, US 79, & US 190 cross in Hearne. The former east-west Missouri Pacific Railroad line converges with the former north-south Southern Pacific Railroad line in Hearne. Union Pacific's Hearne hub sends crews & trains out in many directions.*



*Camp Hearne Exhibit & Visitors Center, a heritage tourism attraction, opened in 2010. During World War II, Camp Hearne was a prisoner-of war camp which housed some 5,000 prisoners from 1942-1946, many of them from General Rommel's Afrika Korps. This attraction features a model of the camp & a*

*replica of one of the barracks, which was built from original floor plans and houses a new on-site visitors center.*

*In Hearne's turn-of-the-century, arrow-shaped depot, antique furnishings & exhibits containing local, railroad, & depot memorabilia are featured. Bricks from the depot's original walkways, an old circular concrete railroad telephone booth, Hearne's restored interlocker console, the old Hearne Lumber Co. entrance gates, an impressive new metal fence are just a few components of*

*Hearne's long-awaited historic attraction. The depot & Camp Hearne are open from 11 a.m.-4 p.m. Wednesdays through Saturdays.*

*Many of the homes and commercial buildings in Hearne's historic district attest to the prosperity of the*



*local area's early plantation owners, railroad builders, merchants, bankers & others. Take the Historic Hearne Tour in person or online to relive Hearne's colorful past and enjoy the architectural*

*splendor of days gone by.*

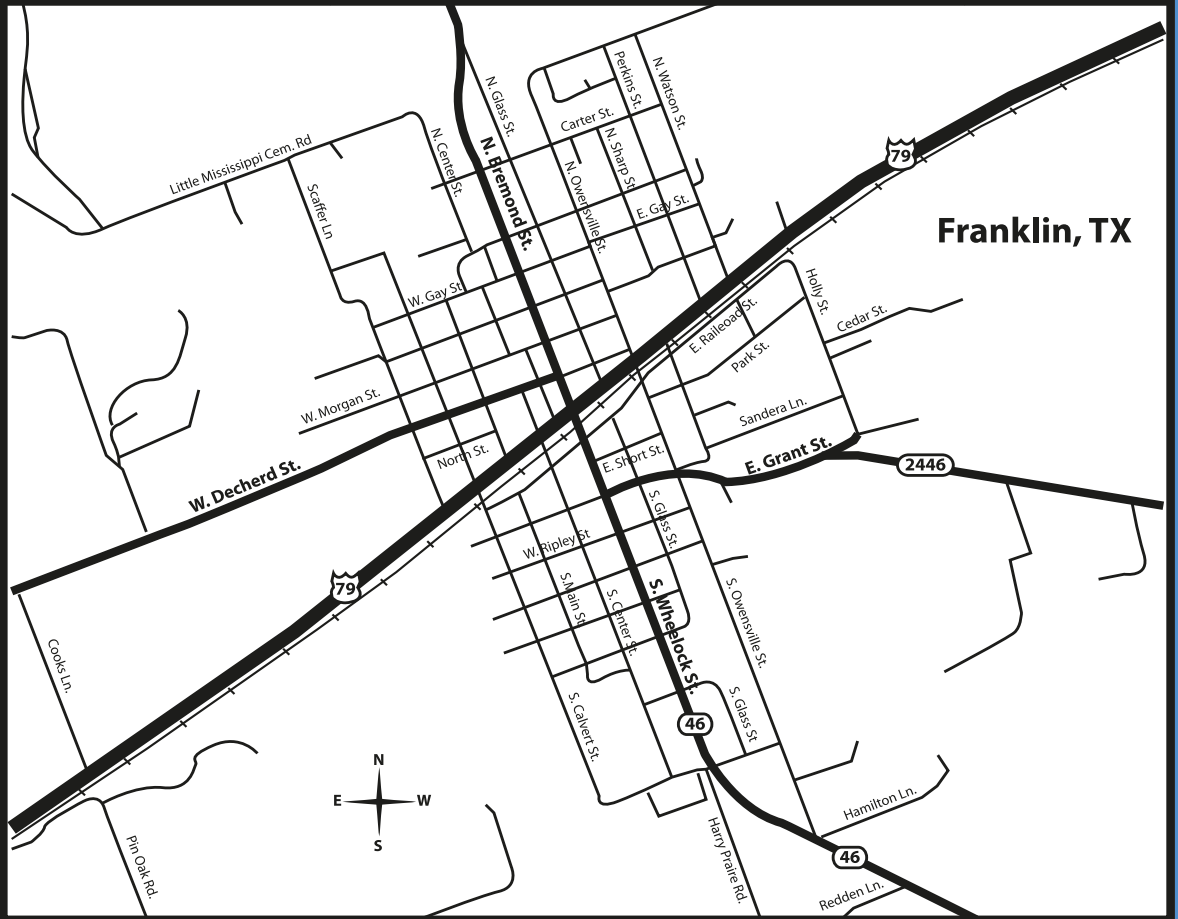
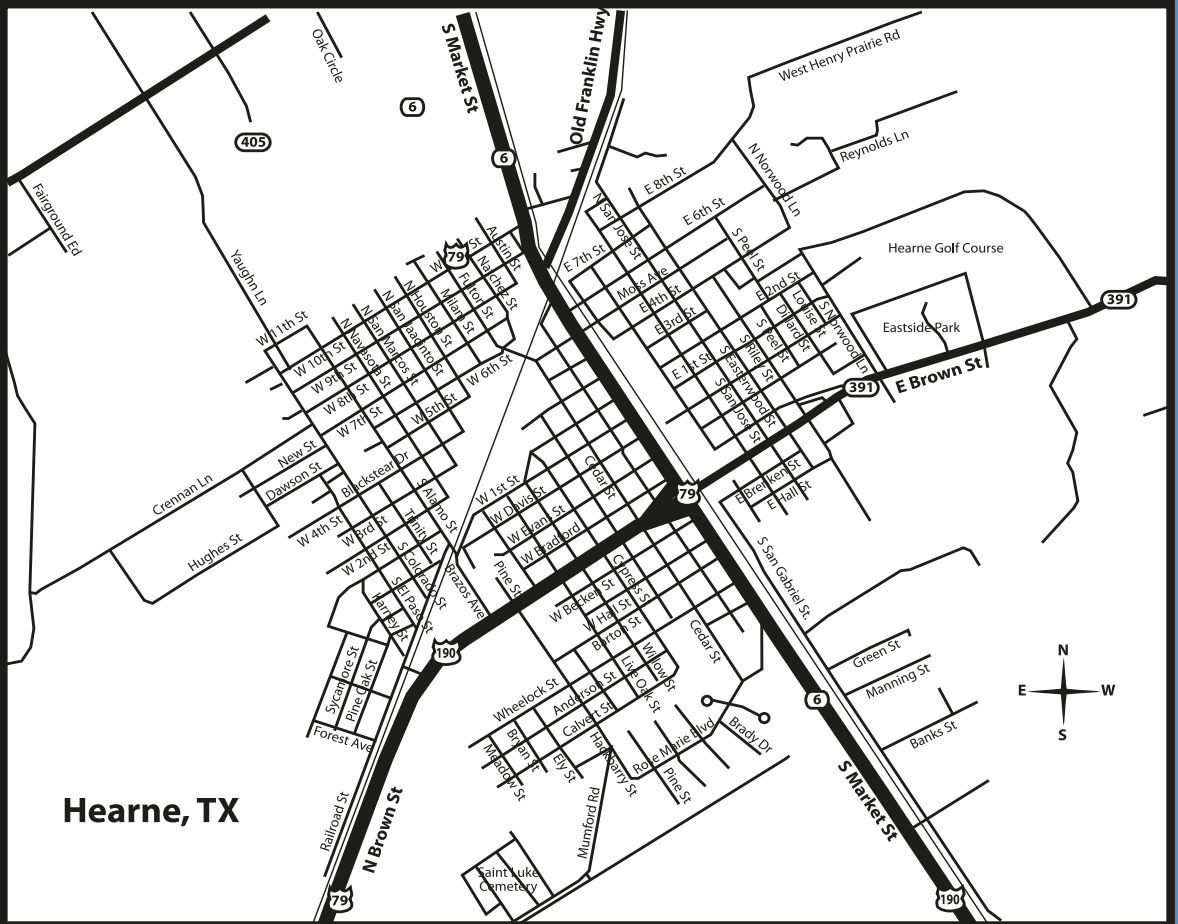
*The Hearne Municipal Airport runway is the longest in central Texas with 7,200 feet of paved infrastructure. Once used as a runway to shoot landings by fighter jets from the Strategic Air Command in San Antonio, the Hearne Airport now hosts Robertson County's Air Weather Observation System (AWOS) which provides pilots and others with local weather conditions.*

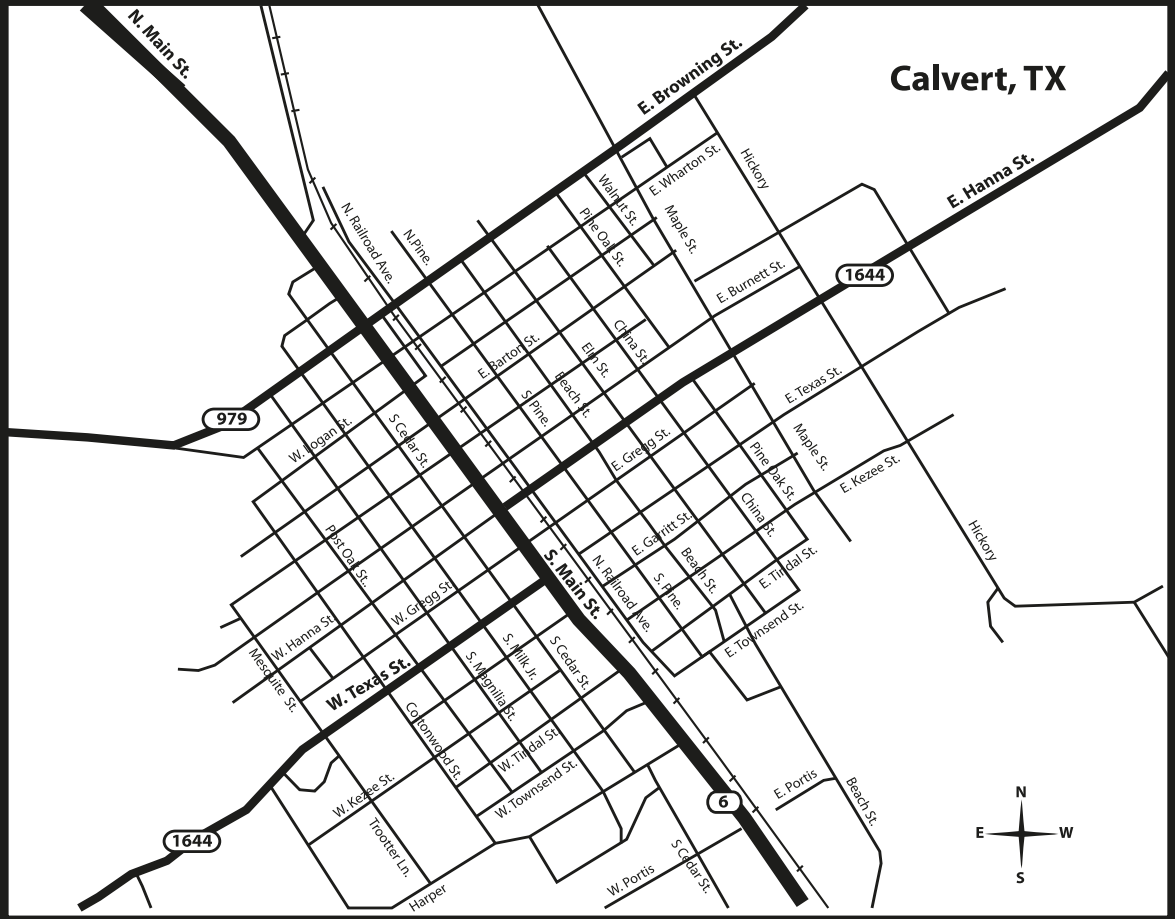
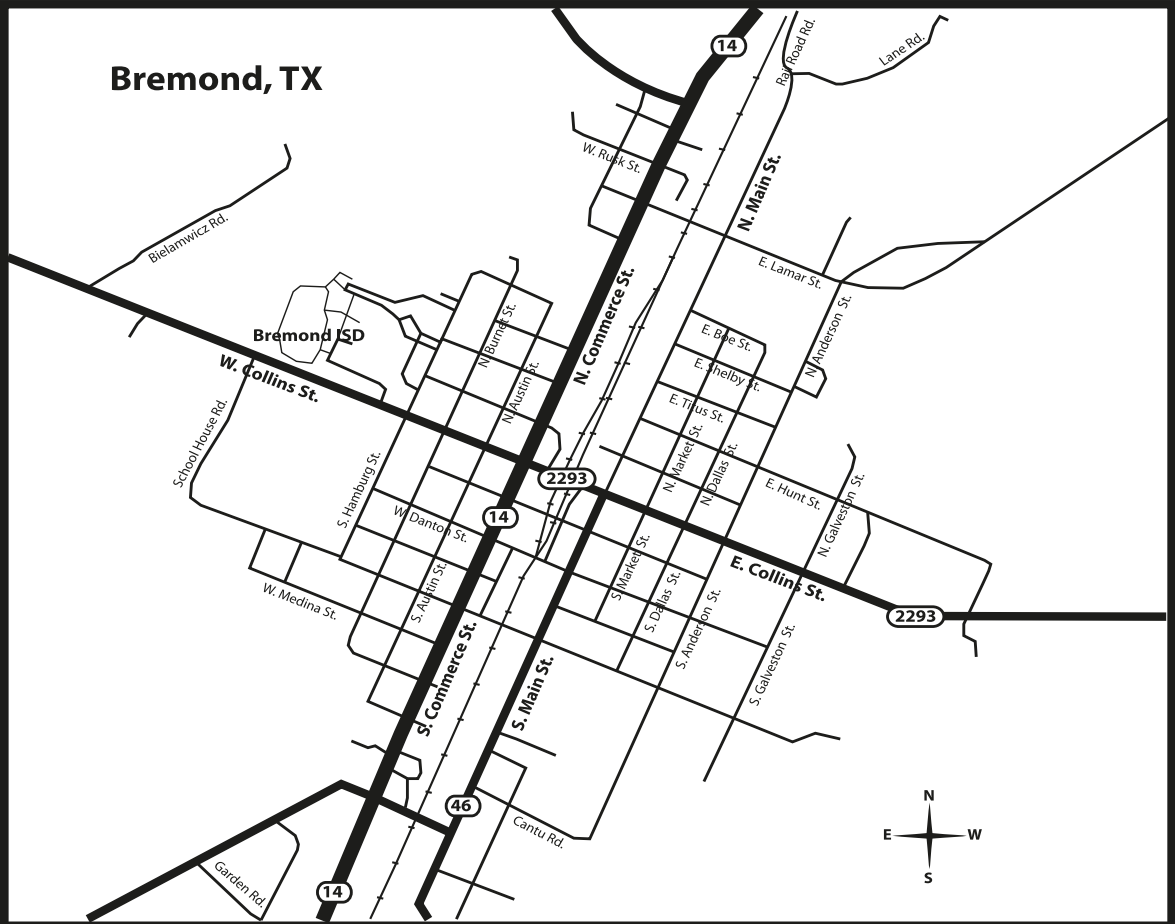
