North Dakota Relay Makes Telecommunications Accessible for Nonstandard Phone Users



What is North Dakota Relay?

North Dakota Relay is a free, completely confidential 24-hour public service that makes the use of the telephone possible and a better experience for many thousands of citizens and visitors of the state who are deaf, hard of hearing, deaf-blind, speech-disabled, and hearing.

How does North Dakota Relay work?

The person dials the toll-free North Dakota Relay number and gives the communications assistant (often abbreviated as the CA) the area code and number of the person receiving the call. An example of a North Dakota Relay service is a highly trained CA who voices the typed comments by the TTY (text telephone) user and types the spoken comments by the other person back to the TTY user. North Dakota Relay provides several options to meet the needs of people who do not use the standard telephone.

* Some buildings with a PBX telephone system (often in hotels and offices that have extension numbers) make reaching 711 not possible. The above 800 numbers can be dialed when not able to get through to 711.

CapTel®—a free captioned phone service

CapTel, short for captioned telephone, users place calls in the same way when dialing with a standard telephone. Utilizing voice recognition technology that displays verbatim captions of the conversation on screen of a telephone or computer screen, the CapTel user can hear and read what the other person is saying.

How do I apply for specialized telephone equipment?

The North Dakota Telecommunications Equipment Distribution Service (TEDS) is a program that provides free equipment for North Dakota residents with qualifying disabilities that interfere with the use of the telephone. Individuals who are experiencing difficulty using their current telephone equipment are encouraged to apply to receive assistive equipment through the TEDS.

711 is not an emergency number

Some people might assume it is okay to call 711 for emergencies. The 711 North Dakota Relay number is for relay service calls only. The Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requires that 911 centers be prepared to handle emergency calls from people who use the text telephone. North Dakota Relay will make every effort to assist a person during an emergency but cannot serve in the same function as 911 centers. North Dakota Relay does not assume responsibility for handling emergency calls.

SERVICE & BILLING

Establishing Or Transferring Phone Service

- TO ESTABLISH OR TO TRANSFER NEW RESIDENTIAL OR BUSINESS PHONE SERVICE, PLEASE CALL YOUR LOCAL SERVICE OFFICE.

To enable us to process your order to establish phone service, we will need to know your complete address, and how you want to be listed in the directory. We also need to know about previous telephone service in your name, and other credit information. We will ask for identification, and a number where you can be reached either at work or through a friend or relative until your service is established.

Installation Rates

Installation rates will vary with the needs of your service. There are many steps involved in installing your service, but not every customer needs each step. The amount of work needed to install service for you will depend on the type of facilities and service you want.

Deposit Policy

Customers may be asked to pay a deposit to establish service. The amount of your deposit is determined when you apply for service.

You Will Be Billed For Changes In Your Service

All changes, except termination of service, and disconnection of certain options, require a service charge. The amount you are charged depends on the type of change requested. Consult your service representative for different services.

How, When & Where To Pay Your Bill

Your payment is due by date printed on bill. Bills may be paid by mail using the return envelope provided, in person at our business office, or at any of the Ramsey Bank locations. There is a charge for each returned check. We also accept Discover, MasterCard, and Visa, or the customer can pay online through e-bill. Contact your local office for additional information.

Error On Your Bill

If you have a question on your bill, call your local service representative. Explain the possible error to the representative who will help you. If the error cannot be resolved, please pay the undisputed charges on time so you'll maintain a good payment record while the problem is being investigated.

Paying The Bill On Time, So Your Service Will Not Be Disconnected

Customers will receive a written Past Due Notice for late payment. Service will be disconnected if payment is not received by date indicated on notice.

How To Get Your Service Restored

All past charges must be paid before your service can be reconnected, and you will be charged a restoral fee. You may be asked to pay a deposit.

ADVANCED CALLING (CLASS SERVICES)

HOW TO USE ADVANCED CALLING SERVICES

Caller Name

Allows you to see the calling party's name before answering a call. A special display located on or next to your phone is required to allow you to view the calling name.

Caller Number

Allows you to see the calling party's number before answering a call. A special display located on or next to your phone is required to allow you to view the calling number.

Caller ID

No dialing instructions are needed. Just connect your Caller ID box to your phone or plug in your Caller ID phone. The Caller ID box or phone will display the name and phone number of the caller.

Caller ID Blocking

This feature prevents your telephone number from being sent to users of the Caller ID service. Blocking is available on a per call basis or per line basis. Per call blocking must be activated from your telephone. NDTc can add a per line block at your request.

To activate: *67 (Rotary 1167)

To deactivate a per line block on a per call basis:
*82 (Rotary 1182)

Anonymous Call Rejection

If you have Caller ID and the party calling you has their number blocked, this service blocks that call from coming through and routes it to a recording. NDTc must activate this feature on your line.

To activate: *77 (Rotary 1177)

To deactivate: *87 (Rotary 1187)

Auto Call Back

You need to reach someone, but their phone is busy. Auto Call Back calls the party you're trying to reach every minute for 30 minutes.

To activate: *66 (Rotary 1166)

To deactivate: *86 (Rotary 1186)

Auto Recall

Your phone rang, but you were unable to answer it in time. With just a touch, Auto Recall will dial the last number that called you.

To activate: *69 (Rotary 1169)

To deactivate: *89 (Rotary 1189)

Customer Originated Trace

To activate this service, immediately pick up the phone and touch: *57 (Rotary phones dial 1157). Listen for a confirmation message indicating that your trace was successful. The number of the last call you received will be recorded by the law enforcement agency. Please keep a note of the times and dates in which you receive a confirmation message indicating that a trace has successfully been performed. If your call cannot be traced, please contact your local telephone company for additional information. Contact the local law enforcement agency to handle the annoyance call problem. There is a fee for each successful trace. This service should only be used to trace life threatening calls or calls which are of a harassing nature in which you may want to press charges.

ADVANCED CALLING (CLASS SERVICES)

HOW TO USE ADVANCED CALLING SERVICES

Custom Ringing

This feature allows you to create a list of 15 incoming numbers that you want to be recognized by a special ring or call waiting tone. Listen for prompts for setting up list of numbers.

To activate: *61 (Rotary 1161)

To deactivate: *61 (Rotary 1161)

Selective Call Acceptance

A list of 15 numbers is prepared by the customer to define what calling numbers will be accepted. Any numbers not on that list will be routed to announcements and rejected. Listen for prompts to set up numbers for acceptance.

To activate: *64 (Rotary 1164)

To deactivate: *84 (Rotary 1184)

Selective Call Forwarding

This service allows you to create a list of 12 calling numbers set up to forward on to a designated remote number where you are able to take calls. Listen for prompts to create your list.

To activate: *63 (Rotary 1163)

To deactivate: *83 (Rotary 1183)

Selective Call Rejection

This service allows you to create a list of 12 numbers that will be routed to an announcement and rejected. All other calls will be treated normally. The rejected party gets an announcement stating that their call is not being accepted by the called party. Listen for prompts to create your list.

To activate: *60 (Rotary 1160)

Contact the local phone company for availability and restrictions.

CUSTOM CALLING

Call Forwarding

Call Forwarding lets you transfer your incoming calls automatically to any other telephone you can dial within the continental U.S.A. without the assistance of an operator.

To Activate:

Dial ***72** and dial the **number** you would like to forward your calls to. It will call the number you are forwarding to.

If they answer: Talk for at least 2 seconds and the feature will be activated. (If answering machine or voicemail answers it will consider the call answered.)

If they don't answer: Hang up & immediately dial ***72**; enter **number** to forward to. You will hear 2 confirmation beeps if feature is activated.

To Deactivate:

Dial ***73**

Some Things To Remember:

- Call forwarding continues until you deactivate it from your telephone.
- You can still make outgoing calls from your telephone while Call Forwarding is established.
- A short ring will be heard whenever your number is called to remind you your telephone calls are forwarded. You cannot answer these calls if other persons use your telephone, let them know when incoming calls are being forwarded especially if they are expecting an important call.
- Don't forget to tell the person who will receive your calls that you are using Call Forwarding especially if you will not be where your calls will be forwarded.
- You pay applicable charges, if any, for calls forwarded from your telephone.

Three - Way Calling

This service lets you add a third person to your conversation.

To Add A Third Person To Your Conversation:

Press the switchhook once, firmly (1/2 second), and release immediately. This puts the original call on "hold." Listen for three short tones, then a dial tone.

Dial the telephone number of the third person to be added. After the third person answers, you may talk with that person before returning to the original call.

To return the original caller to the line and complete the three-way conversation, press the switchhook once, firmly, (1/2 second), and release immediately.

NOTE: If the line is busy or doesn't answer, cancel the three-way call by pressing the switchhook once. Continue the original conversation or try again.

To Remove Either Person From The Conversation:

The original called party just hangs up to disconnect. The third person is removed by your pressing the switchhook once and releasing it immediately, or by the third person simply hanging up. All three connections are automatically disconnected when you hang up.

To Add A Different Person:

Perform a "remove" step. Then repeat the first four steps.

CUSTOM CALLING (Cont'd)

Speed Calling

Speed calling provides one-digit codes for up to 30 of the telephone numbers you call most. You can dial both local and long distance calls with Speed Calling.

To Place A Speed Call:

When you hear the dial tone, dial the Speed Calling code (2 through 9) assigned to the number you're calling. If your telephone is Touch-Tone and equipped with the pound symbol (#) key, press the code number and then the # key.

To Add Or Change A Speed Call Code Number:

8-Code Speed Calling:

- Listen for dial tone, then dial activating code 74 #.
- Listen for a second dial tone, then dial the Speed Calling code number (2 through 9) to be changed or added.
- Next, dial the local or complete long distance number you want assigned to that code number.
- Two short tones indicate the new code and telephone number combination have been recorded.

To save a number using Speed Calling 30...

- (1) Listen for a dial tone.
- (2) Dial 7 5 #, (or dial "75" on your rotary phone.)
- (3) Listen for a second dial tone.
- (4) Dial a two digit code for each number (20 through 49), followed by the telephone number the code represents.
- (5) Two short tones indicate the number has been stored.

To place a call...

- (1) Listen for a dial tone.
- (2) Dial one of the Speed Calling codes followed by the # button.
- (3) Your call will go through after a short pause.

Calling Waiting

This service lets you answer a second call while you are using your telephone.

How It Works:

A short tone signals that another person is trying to call you when you are on the phone. The incoming caller only hears the usual ringing signal. You can put one call on hold while handling the second call, or alternate between the two.

To Answer The Second Call:

If you wish to end the first call, hang up. Your phone will ring and the second (incoming) caller will be on the line. If you want to hold the first call while answering the second call, press the switchhook once firmly, (1/2 second) and release it immediately. You will be connected with the other person on your line. (Use the recall button on Trimline® models.)

Returning To The First Call:

To return to the first call, simply press the switchhook once firmly, (1/2 second) and release it immediately. With this method you can switch between the two calls as frequently as you wish.

How To End Either Conversation:

After you have finished talking with either caller, hang up. Your phone will ring and when you answer you will be connected with the person remaining on the line.

Cancel Call Waiting

Turn on Cancel Call Waiting when you're making an important call and talk as long as you want with no interruptions. Calling party will receive recorded message that call cannot be completed. After you finish your call, Call Waiting returns automatically when you hang up the phone. Cancel Call Waiting assures you of uninterrupted phone calls during important conversations, when talking long distance or when using your personal computer modem.

Instructions:

- (1) Listen for a dial tone.
- (2) Dial 7 0 #.
- (3) Listen for three short tones, followed by a normal dial tone.
- (4) Dial a telephone number.

During a call...

- (1) Press the switchhook (the button that hangs up the phone) for one second.
- (2) Dial 7 0 #.
- (3) A tone will be heard and you will be automatically reconnected to your call.

VOICE MAIL

Accessing Your Mailbox

1. Dial your local voicemail number provided by your telephone company or ***97** from your premises.
Then:
 - **Press #** if you're calling from the phone your voice mail is assigned to.
 - **Enter your seven-digit telephone number followed by the # key**, if calling from a different location, OR
 - If using **Auto Login** and accessing from your home phone no entry is required.
2. If requested, **enter your password, followed by the # key**. Your password will be a default of four zeros (0000) until you change it.
3. If you have any messages, the most recent message will automatically begin playing preceded by the date/time. You can by-pass the date/time stamp by pressing **1** at this time.
4. To get to the main menu, **press the * key**.

Setting Up Your Mailbox

1. Access your mailbox.
2. Press **9** from the main menu (Mailbox Set-up).

Changing Your Password

1. Access your mailbox.
2. **Press 9** from the main menu (Mailbox Set-up).
3. **Press 2** from the set-up menu (Change Password).
4. **Enter your new password, followed by the # key**. The password is any series of up to 16 digits you choose. You will be unable to access your mailbox without this password, so be sure to choose one you will remember.
5. **To verify, enter your password, followed by the # key**.

Auto Login

From the Set-up menu, you can enable or disable the auto login feature by pressing **4** and following the prompts. The auto login feature allows you to by-pass password entry when calling from the telephone your voice mail is assigned to.

Note: Auto Login is not password protected. Anyone accessing voicemail from your telephone can listen to your messages if Auto Login is enabled unless they press ****** to access another mailbox.

Record Or Change Greeting

1. Access you mailbox.
2. **Press 9** from the main menu (Mailbox Set-up).
3. **Press 1** from set-up menu (Greeting Options).
4. **Press 2** and record your greeting.
5. **Press #** key to end your recording.
6. **Press 1** to listen to your greeting.
7. **Press the * key** to return to the main menu.

Retrieving Messages

Once you have accessed your voice mailbox your current messages will begin to play. (If you have older messages that you previously saved, you will be asked if you want to hear new messages or saved ones.)

OR From the main menu **press 1** (message retrieval). Then choose between **1** (new message) or **2** (saved message).

EQUIPMENT INFORMATION

Recording Or Monitoring Phone Calls

Anyone who records or monitors a phone conversation is required to make this known to all parties in the conversation. The party doing the monitoring or recording must ask the other persons' permission to record or monitor the conversation.

When using the public utility telephone network:

- A. All parties in the conversation must consent to the conversation being recorded or monitored; and
- B. The monitoring or recording must be signaled by either:
 - 1. a "beep tone" audible to all parties and repeated at regular intervals during the conversation; or
 - 2. clearly and permanently marking the telephones being used that the conversation may be recorded without notice.

Phone Receiver Off The Hook

At times you may not wish to receive incoming calls. Please do not leave the receiver off the hook as this unnecessarily congests the switching equipment. In some cases, we may have to disconnect your line to avoid overloading the equipment. When this occurs, your telephone will not work until it is reconnected in our switching office. We suggest if your phone is equipped with a jack, simply unplug it.



2-1-1 is a toll-free, statewide, crisis intervention, information and referral service that operates 24 hours per day, seven days a week. It is unique in that it is always answered by trained staff and volunteers - there are no answering machines or voicemail systems to navigate. We are accredited by the American Association of Suidology and a member of the Alliance of Information and Referral Systems (AIRS).

Attachments To Telephone Equipment

Attachments connected to the telephone company's lines must be in compliance with company tariffs and Federal Communications Commission regulations.

Telephone Safety

The telephone is one of the safest appliances in your home or office. There are, however, a few situations where a telephone user needs to be cautious.

Use Of The Telephone Near Water

The telephone should not be used while you are in the bathtub, shower or pool. Immersion of the telephone or handset in water could cause electrical shock.

Use Of The Telephone During An Electrical Storm

You should avoid using a telephone during an electrical storm in your immediate area; calls of an urgent nature should be brief. There is a remote risk of a dangerous electrical shock from lightning when using the telephone during a nearby electrical storm.

Use Of The Telephone To Report A Gas Leak

If you think you have found a gas leak, you should not use a telephone in the vicinity of the leak until the leak is repaired. The telephone contains electrical contacts that could generate a tiny spark when you lift the handset and dial. While unlikely, it may be possible for this spark to trigger an explosion if the gas concentration is high enough.

CUSTOMER INFORMATION

Recognizing Telephone Company Employees

For your protection, every telephone company employee carries an identification badge with a picture and the employee's name and identification number. Contractors working for the telephone company also have badges that state their affiliation with us.

Directory Information

Looking for more business? Advertise in the telephone company's Yellow Pages. Call your local service office for information.

Additional local directories may be obtained at your service office.

Directory Listings

Your name will automatically be added to our white pages when you have a phone installed unless you ask for an Unlisted Number.

You can add other phone numbers if you wish:

Additional Residence Listings are for other people in your household with different last names.

Additional Business Listings can put your name as well as your business' name in the White Pages.

Alternate Call Listings give another phone number for after-hours calls or if there is no one to answer at the first phone number.

Every effort is made to make the directory as accurate as possible. If an error occurs, please advise the service office so the listing can be corrected in future directories.

• **Non-Listed Service:** We can omit your listing from the White Pages but retain it in our Directory Assistance records. This service is available for a small monthly charge.

• **Non-Published Service:** For even more privacy, we can omit your listing from both the White Pages and Directory Assistance records. This service is available for a small monthly charge.

Errors In Directory Listings

The Telephone Company issues directories to assist in furnishing prompt and efficient service and it does not guarantee to its subscribers correct listings therein. Every precaution is taken to prevent errors in, and omissions of, directory listings but they may occur and the Telephone Company and Publishers of this directory will assume no liability for damages caused to a subscriber because of such errors or omissions.

Number Changes

The telephone company reserves the right to and may, at its discretion, change the customer's telephone number.

Rates & Policies

Copies of our rules and regulations and schedules of rates are available at our service office and are open to public inspection.

Handling Unwanted Phone Calls

If you do not want to talk to a person selling a product or service by telephone, just say "no thank you," and hang up.

If you're bothered by harassing or anonymous phone calls, try these techniques to discourage them.

Always hang up immediately at the first obscene word or if the person on the other end of the line doesn't respond after you've said "hello" twice.

Don't talk to the caller. This is what he or she wants you to do.

Don't give out any information or let the caller know if you're alone. Teach your children to say "Mom or Dad can't come to the phone. May I take a message?"

If the problem occurs continuously over an extended period, you should report it to your local law enforcement agency. Keep a record of the days and times of the calls, and note the caller's gender, voice, accent and comments. This information could assist the police.

It is a crime to make harassing, obscene or anonymous phone calls under both federal and state laws.

Prosecuting Fraudulent Callers

It is illegal for another person to charge long distance calls to your number or calling card without your permission. People using unauthorized calling cards or phone numbers to avoid charges are subject to prosecution and may be imprisoned, fined, or both.

• **Fraud:** For your protection, NDTC is able to detect fraudulent calls. State and Federal laws provide that no person shall defraud or attempt to defraud the Telephone Company of its lawful charges.

CONSUMER RIGHTS

Statement Of Nondiscrimination

This telephone company has filed with the Federal Government a Compliance Assurance in which it assures the Rural Electrification Administration that it will comply fully with all requirements of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Agriculture issued thereunder, to the end that no person in the United States shall, on the ground of race, color or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination in the conduct of its program and the operation of its facilities. Under this Assurance, this organization is committed not to discriminate against any person on the ground of race, color, or national origin in its policies and practices relating to applications for service or any other policies and practices relating to treatment of beneficiaries and participants including rates, condition and extension of service, use of any of its facilities, attendance at and participation in any

meetings of beneficiaries and participants or the exercise of any rights of such beneficiaries and participants in the conduct of the operations of this organization.

Any person who believes himself, or any specific class of individuals, to be subjected by this organization to discrimination prohibited by Title VI of the Act and the Rules and Regulations issued thereunder may, by himself or a representative, file with the Secretary of Agriculture, Washington, D. C. 20250, or the Rural Electrification Administration, Washington, D. C. 20250, or this organization, or all, a written complaint. Such complaint must be filed no later than 90 days after the alleged discrimination, or by such later date to which the Secretary of Agriculture or the Rural Electrification Administration extends the time for filing. Identity of complainants will be kept confidential except to the extent necessary to carry out the purpose of the Rules and Regulations.

If You Use 900 Pay-Per-Call Services

You have rights we'd like you to know about:

(Under Federal Telephone Disclosure and Dispute Resolution Act)

- * There is no charge for your initial request to block 900 calls from your home.
- * You have 60 days after receiving a bill to dispute 900 pay-per-call errors. While the errors are in review, you have the right to withhold payment for the disputed charges, and no collection activity will be brought against you for those charges. (If the charges are found legitimate, the long distance carrier or information provider may start a collection process against your account.)
- * Your local and/or long distance service cannot be disconnected if you fail to pay your 900 charges. (If you do not pay legitimate 900 charges, the carrier has the right to block your 900 access.)
- * You should not be billed for pay-per-call services that do not comply with federal laws and regulations.

CONSUMER RIGHTS (Cont'd)

Liability Of Utility

- A. The liability of the Company for damages arising out of mistakes, omissions, interruptions, delays errors or defects in transmission occurring in the course of furnishing service or other facilities, and not caused by the negligence of the customer, shall in no event exceed an amount equivalent to the proportionate charge to the customer for the period of service during which such mistake, omission, interruption, delay, error or defect in transmission occurs. The maximum refund or charge will not exceed an estimated amount equal to such charge or refund for a 3 year period. No other liability shall in any case attach to the Company.
- B. The Company shall be indemnified and saved harmless (including costs and reasonable attorneys' fees) by the customer or customers against claims for libel, slander, or the infringement of copyright arising directly or indirectly from the material transmitted over the facilities or the use thereof; against claims for infringement of patents arising from combining with or using in connection with, facilities furnished by the Company, apparatus, systems and their associated wiring of the customer; and against all other claims arising out of any act or omission of a customer in connection with the facilities provided by the Company.
- C. The Company is not liable for any defacement of or damage to the premises or property of a customer resulting from the existence of facilities furnished by the Company on the premises, or the installation or removal of such facilities, unless such defacement or damage is the result of the negligence of the Company.
- D. When lines of another telephone company are used in establishing connections to points not reached by the lines of the Company, the Company is not liable for any act or omission of that other company.

Interruption Of Service

The specific form of rule applicable to interruptions in exchange telephone service is as follows:

The utility shall allow, for interruptions in exchange telephone service of 24 hours or more not due to conduct of the customer, an amount equal to the fixed monthly charges for exchange service multiplied by the ratio of the days of interruption to thirty days. When interruptions continue beyond 24 hours, credit allowances will be given in successive 24-hour multiples.

Similar but not identical provisions apply to private lines and other telephone services.

For details of provisions covering allowances for interruption in such other services you should call your service office.

Liability For Directory Advertising

For errors or omissions in listings or advertisements in telephone directories, allowances are provided as follows:

- A. For listings in telephone directories furnished at additional charge, an amount not in excess of the charge for that listing during the effective life of the directory in which the error or omission occurred.
- B. For advertisements in classified directories, an amount based upon pro rata abatement of the charge in such degree as the error or omission affected the advertisement.

For information on allowances available in the event of errors or omissions in information records or in TWX or other special directories, you should contact your nearest service office.

CAN'T AFFORD TELEPHONE SERVICE: LINK UP AND LIFELINE PROGRAMS CAN HELP

Lifeline

NDTC Telephone and Internet services are Lifeline supported services. Lifeline is a government program that lowers the cost of monthly local telephone or qualifying Internet services. Eligible consumers can receive a discount of up to \$9.25 per month. Eligible residents of Tribal lands can receive up to \$34.25 in Lifeline support.

Lifeline support can be used on either telephone or a qualifying Internet service, but not on both. The option to apply the discount to a qualifying service bundle, such as home phone and Internet service, is also available from NDTC.

One Lifeline discount is allowed per household* and cannot be transferred to someone else.

Link Up

Link Up reduces the cost of initiating new telephone service to eligible residents of Tribal lands at the subscriber's principal place of residence. Consumers can receive a 100% discount off of the one-time cost of initiating service. Link Up is a one-time benefit per address; subscribers can request Link Up once for each change of primary residential address.

Eligibility Guidelines

Applicants, or someone in the applicants household*, who participate in one of the following programs may be eligible to receive Lifeline benefits:

- Medicaid
- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Federal Public Housing Assistance
- Veterans Pension and Survivors Benefit Programs

Residents of Tribal lands qualify if they participate in any of the above programs or of the following:

- Tribally Administered Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TTANF)
- Bureau of Indian Affairs General Assistance
- Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPIR)
- Head Start (those meeting its income-qualifying standards)

Consumers with household* income at or below 135% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines are also eligible for support.

**A household is defined as any individual or group of income address as one economic unit.*

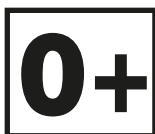
Direct Distance Dialing

Direct dial if you wish to talk with anyone who answers. Rates for calls that you dial yourself are lower than for calls dialed by the operator. Charging begins when the called telephone is answered in person or by an automatic answering machine.

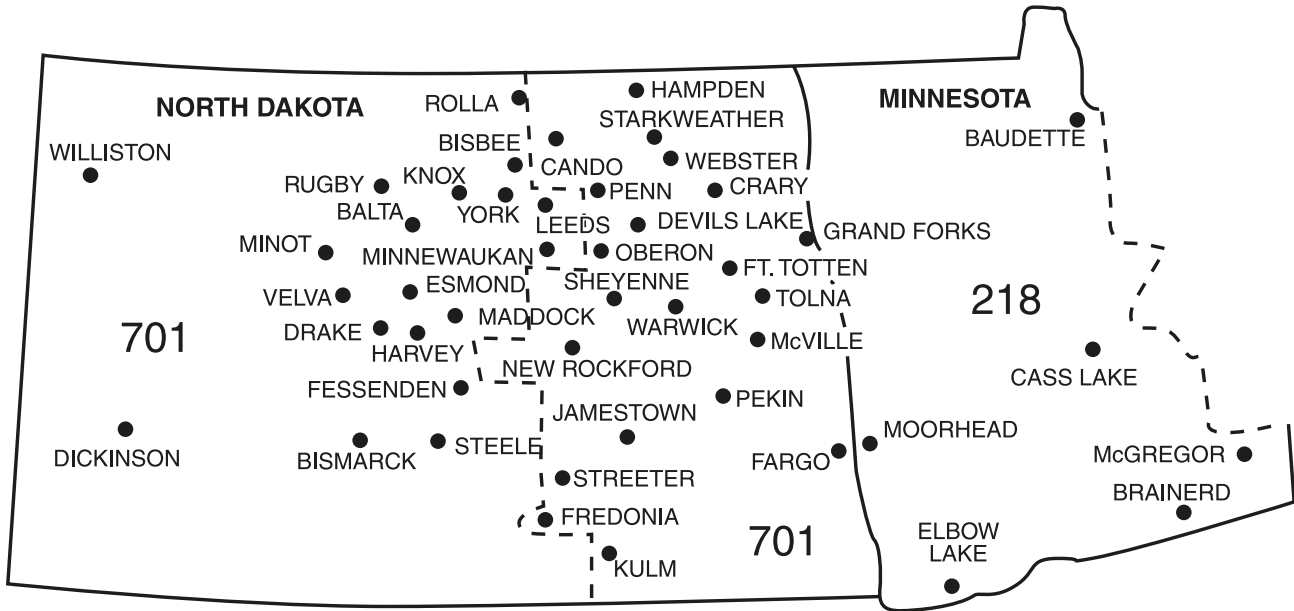

BISMARCK LATA

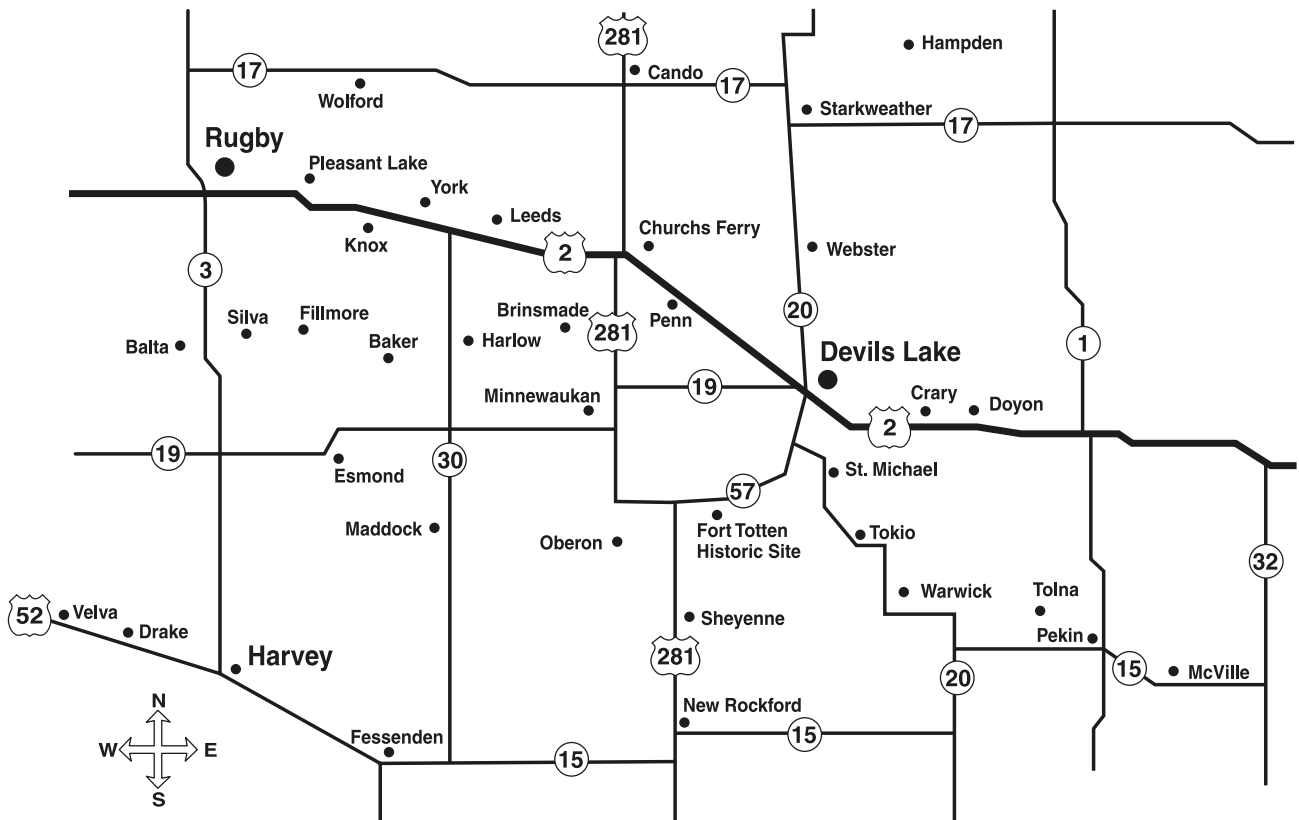
FARGO/BRAINERD LATA
