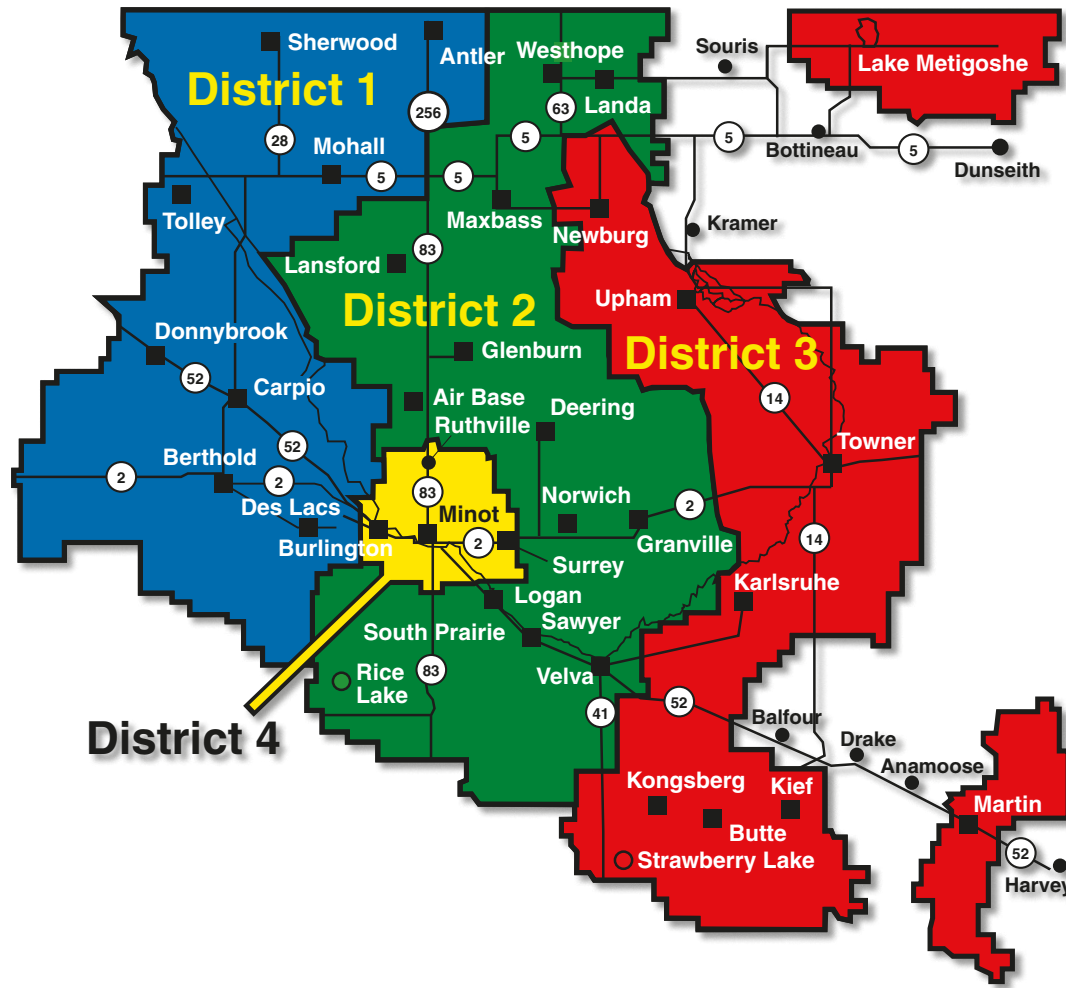

Calling Features / Traditional

Anonymous Call Rejection

You can reject incoming calls from calling parties who choose to keep their number private. The calling party will receive an announcement informing them that the person they are attempting to reach does not accept calls from blocked numbers.

To Activate Anonymous Call Rejection:

1. Listen for dial tone and dial *77.
2. A confirmation tone will indicate the service is activated.

To Deactivate Anonymous Call Rejection:

1. Listen for dial tone and dial *87.
2. A confirmation tone will indicate the service is deactivated.

Note: Calls from areas that do not support the Caller ID service will not be rejected. These calls will show on your Caller ID display as “out of area” or “unknown caller.”

Call Forward Remote Activation

Activate and deactivate your Call Forwarding from another telephone number.

To Set PIN Number:

This must be done from the phone on which you have Call Forward Remote Activation.

1. Listen for dial tone and dial *97 to access the main menu.
2. Voice prompt will ask for the access code of the feature you want to change.
3. Dial *98.
4. Enter your current PIN (last four digits of your telephone number).
5. Enter new PIN.
6. Re-enter new PIN and hang up.

To Activate Call Forward Remote Activation:

1. Dial the telephone number to access Call Forward Remote Activation: 858-0000.
2. Enter your 7 digit phone number that has remote activation service, followed by the PIN number.
3. Dial *72 and the telephone number where you want your calls forwarded (include area code if necessary).
4. To confirm, dial 1 and hang up.

To Deactivate Call Forward Remote Activation:

1. Repeat steps 1 and 2 above.
2. Press *73 and hang up.

Notes:

- You must also subscribe to Call Forwarding for this service to work.
- Pressing # after each entry will speed up the process.

Call Forwarding

Forward your calls to another phone.

To set up Call Forwarding:

1. Lift the handset, listen for the dial tone and dial *72.
2. Listen for a second dial tone.
3. Dial the number you want your calls to be forwarded to. Speed Calling codes may be used if you have this feature.

To cancel Call Forwarding:

1. Lift the handset, listen for the dial tone and dial *73.
2. Listen for two beeps which indicate call forwarding is cancelled, then hang up.

Notes:

- Once you've activated Call Forwarding, you will hear one short ring each time a call is forwarded.
- You can still make outgoing calls from the phone.
- To change the number your calls are forwarded to, cancel the feature and set it up again.

Call Transfer

You can transfer a call to another party and hang up making your line available for other calls.

To Transfer a Call:

1. With a call in progress, press the hook switch or flash button. This will put the call on hold.
2. Listen for a confirmation tone and dial the telephone number where you want to transfer the call.
3. You can announce the call or hang up and the two parties will be connected.
4. If you press the hook switch or flash again, you've established a 3-way call.

If you reach a busy signal, unanswered ringing line, or wrong number while attempting to transfer a call, press the flash button once to join the busy signal, ringing line, or wrong number with you and the original party. Press the flash button again to drop the busy signal, ringing line, or wrong number. You will remain connected to your original party.

Note: If you transfer a call out of your local service area, you will accumulate toll charges as long as the other two parties remain connected.

Calling Features / Traditional

Call Waiting

While you're on a call, Call Waiting alerts you that you have another incoming call.

How it alerts you:

1. A beep tone indicates another call is waiting. Only you hear the tone, the caller hears a normal ringing tone.
2. You will hear a reminder beep tone 10 seconds later.
3. Depress the hook switch or flash button for 1 second to place your first call on hold and you will be connected to the second caller.

Alternate between calls:

1. Depress and release the hook switch or flash button once for each transfer. Each conversation is private and cannot be heard by the other caller.

Terminate either call:

1. Simply hang up. Your telephone will ring and when you answer, you will be connected with the other caller. The call you discontinued will no longer be on the line.

Notes:

- If two calls are on a line at one time, anyone calling will receive a busy signal.
- The Call Waiting beep doesn't have to be answered. After 10 seconds there is one reminder beep and if not answered, the calling party will continue to hear ringing.

Call Waiting Caller ID

See who's calling when you're on another call.

How to use:

1. When you are on the phone, you will hear a distinct Call Waiting tone.
2. The caller's name and/or number will show on your phone display.
3. You can choose whether or not to answer the call.

Notes:

- Your phone display unit must be compatible with Call Waiting Caller ID.
- You must also subscribe to Call Waiting and Caller ID for this service to work.

Call Wake-up

Your telephone can be used as an alarm clock.

How to use:

1. Lift the handset, listen for the dial tone and dial *94.
2. You will receive a confirmation tone.
3. Dial a four digit wake-up time, plus the number of rings desired, plus the # sign. The desired time must be entered in 24 hour format. Example: Enter 0700

for 7:00 a.m. or 1830 for 6:30 p.m. The time must be entered daily. The desired number of rings can range from 2-9, but must be entered in a two digit format. Example: If you desire three rings, dial 03. If you do not enter a desired ring count, you will automatically receive 9 rings.

To cancel a Wake-up call:

1. Lift the handset, listen for a dial tone and dial *95.
2. After you hear a confirmation tone, hang up.

Caller ID Block

Prevent your name and telephone number from being displayed to the person you're calling. Choose permanent Caller ID Block or block your calls on a per-call basis.

How to use Per-Call Blocking:

1. Listen for the dial tone and dial *67.
2. Dial the number you wish to call.
3. The person you call will not be able to see your name and number displayed on their phone display screen, instead, "private" will be displayed. (not guaranteed outside local area)

To Deactivate Caller ID Block:

If you subscribe to permanent Caller ID Block and you wish to unblock your line on a per-call basis, do the following:

1. Listen for the dial tone and dial *82.
2. Dial the number you wish to call.
3. The person you've called will be able to see your name and number on their phone display unit.

Note: For per-call blocking you MUST dial *67 before each call you place otherwise, your name and telephone number will be displayed to the person receiving your call.

Caller ID Number – Caller ID Name & Number

See the telephone number or name and number of the person calling before you answer the phone. Identify annoying or harassing calls and select the calls you choose to answer.

How to use:

1. When receiving a call, wait until your telephone completes the first ring as calls are identified between the first and second rings.
2. The telephone number, or name & number, will automatically appear on your phone display.

Notes

- If "private" appears on your phone display, the caller may have blocked their name and number from displaying.
- If "unknown number" or "out of area" appears, the caller is in an area that does not support the Caller ID service.

Calling Features / Traditional

Cancel Call Waiting

Cancel Call Waiting is when you don't want a call to be interrupted.

Activate prior to making a call:

1. Lift the handset and listen for the normal dial tone.
2. Dial *70 and listen for a second dial tone. Call Waiting is disabled for the duration of the call and will automatically be turned back on when you hang up.

Activate while on a call:

1. Depress the hook switch or flash button to obtain a second dial tone.
2. Dial *70 and listen for a confirmation tone. The system will automatically re-establish the original connection. When your call is completed, hang up and call waiting is automatically restored.

Note: If you activate Cancel Call Waiting, anyone calling while you are on the line will receive a busy signal.

Conference Calling

"Meet Me Conference" is a conference bridge located in SRT's Central office which allows up to 30 conferees to dial in to a predetermined number to establish a conference call.

How to use:

1. All conference members enter the bridge by dialing the bridge directory number.
2. A short ring alerting tone is heard by all members each time someone enters the bridge.
3. A short dial tone signal is heard each time someone leaves the conference bridge.

Call SRT's Business Office at 852-8888 for more information.

Continuous Redial

Keep redialing busy numbers and be notified when the line becomes available.

How to use:

1. After calling a number and reaching a busy signal, hang up. Lift the handset again and listen for the dial tone and dial *66. You will hear a message indicating that you have activated the service. Hang up.
2. Your phone will continue to call the busy line for up to 30 minutes.
3. A distinctive callback ring alerts you when the line becomes free. When you hear the distinctive ring, lift the handset and wait for the called party to answer.

To cancel:

1. Listen for the dial tone and dial *86.
2. Listen for a confirmation message and hang up.

Note: You may place other calls while Continuous Redial attempts to reach a busy number.

Custom Ringing

Custom Ringing allows two additional phone numbers to be assigned to a main line. A unique ring is assigned to each number.

Person Calling dials:

- Main line number
- First additional number
- Second additional number

Called party with Call Waiting hears:

- Normal single tone
- 2 short tones
- Short long short

Called party hears:

- Normal ring
- 2 short rings
- Short long short

Call SRT's Customer Service at 852-1200 to set up this service.

Customer Originated Trace

Trace harassing calls and at your request, your local law enforcement agency will investigate. This should only be used to trace life threatening calls or calls which are of a harassing nature in which you may want to press charges.

How to use:

1. When you receive a harassing or threatening call, hang up. Immediately pick up the handset and listen for the dial tone.
2. Dial *57 and listen for a message indicating that you have successfully activated the tracing feature.
3. Hang up.
4. The number you traced will be recorded at the law enforcement agency. If you decide to follow up on the matter, you will need to work directly with your local law enforcement agency for further investigation.

Notes:

- Customer Originated Trace must be used immediately after you hang up on the call you want traced. If you receive another call or a call waiting tone before activating a trace, you will trace the wrong call.
- It is a good idea to keep note of the date and time you activated a trace.
- **The traced number will only be available to your local law enforcement agency. Under no circumstances will you be given the traced number.**

Calling Features / Traditional

Distinctive Ring Call Waiting

Create a list of up to 12 specific telephone numbers from which calls will ring in a unique pattern. When someone on your list calls you, their call will ring with a different tone. If you're on the phone and another caller from your list calls, the Call Waiting tone will be unique from a regular Call Waiting beep. All other calls not included on your Distinctive Ring Call Waiting list will ring to your line as normal.

To Access Distinctive Ring Call Waiting:

1. Listen for dial tone and dial *61 to access the main menu.
2. Continue following the prompts to establish your list.
3. Press 3 to turn the service on/off.

Notes:

- You must also subscribe to Call Waiting for this service to work.
- Area limitations may apply when establishing your list.

Last Call Return

Dial the last number that called you.

How to use:

1. Listen for dial tone and dial *69. You will hear a message describing the steps required to complete the callback.

If the line is busy:

1. You will hear a message telling you the line is busy and how to proceed. Hang up and your phone will continue to place the call every minute up to 30 minutes.
2. A distinctive callback ring alerts you when the line becomes available.
3. Pick up the handset and wait for the called party to answer.

To cancel:

1. Listen for dial tone and dial *89. You will hear a recording telling you that Last Call Return is deactivated.
2. Hang up.

Selective Call Acceptance

Screen incoming calls by creating a list of up to 12 telephone numbers from which you are willing to accept calls. Calls from telephone numbers not included in your list will receive an announcement informing them that you are not accepting calls at this time.

To Create your Selective Call Acceptance List:

1. Listen for the dial tone and dial *64 to access the main menu.
2. Continue following the prompts to establish your list.
3. Long distance numbers must be programmed as a "private" entry immediately after the call takes place. Listen for dial tone and dial *64 followed by #, 01, #.
4. Press 3 to turn the service on/off.

Selective Call Forwarding

Create a list of up to 12 specific telephone numbers from which calls will be forwarded to a number of your choice. When someone on your list calls you, their call will ring at the forwarding number. All other calls not included on your Selective Call Forwarding list will ring to your line as usual.

To Access Selective Call Forwarding:

1. Listen for dial tone and dial *63 to access the main menu.
2. Continue following the prompts to establish your list.
3. Press 3 to turn the service on/off.

Selective Call Rejection

Create a list of up to 12 telephone numbers from which you do not wish to receive calls. Calls from telephone numbers included in your list will receive an announcement informing them that you are not accepting calls at this time.

To Create your Selective Call Rejection List:

1. Listen for the dial tone and dial *60 to access the main menu.
2. Continue following the prompts to establish your list.
3. Long distance numbers must be programmed as a "private" entry immediately after the call takes place. Listen for dial tone and dial *60 followed by #, 01, #.
4. Press 3 to turn the service on/off.

Notes:

- Area limitations may apply when establishing your list.
- Selective Call Rejection takes precedence over Selective Call Forwarding and Anonymous Call Rejection.

Calling Features / Traditional

Simultaneous Ring (SIM Ring)

Program up to four additional telephone numbers to ring at the same time with SIM Ring. For example, a call made to you at your home can ring your wireless phone, your office phone, your lake cabin phone and your friend's phone, all at the same time. The first one to answer accepts the call.

To Access SIM Ring:

1. Listen for dial tone and dial *80 to access the main menu.
2. Continue following the prompts to establish your list.
3. Press 3 to turn the service on/off.

To Access SIM Ring Remotely:

1. Listen for dial tone and dial 858-0001.
2. Enter your telephone number including the area code.
3. Enter your PIN (defaults to last four digits of your telephone number) and follow the prompts.

To Change your PIN (Personal Identification Number)

This must be done from the phone you have SIM Ring activated on.

1. Listen for dial tone and dial *97 to access the main menu.
2. The voice prompt will ask for the access code for the feature you want to change.
3. Dial *80 and enter your current PIN (last four digits of your telephone number).
4. Enter a new PIN.
5. Re-enter the new PIN and then hang up.

Note: Pressing # after each entry will speed up the entry process.

Speed Call 8

Call your 8 most frequently dialed numbers quickly, easily and accurately.

To store or change your Speed Call numbers:

1. Listen for dial tone and dial *74.
2. Dial the Speed Call number (0 through 9) you have selected and the complete telephone number it will represent (example 2 + 555-1111), then depress the # button. Remember to include the 1 + area code for long distance entries.
3. Repeat the above steps for each number to be stored.

To use a Speed Call number:

1. Listen for dial tone and press the * button.
2. Dial the appropriate one-digit speed call number and your call will be dialed automatically.

Speed Call 30

Call your 30 most frequently dialed numbers quickly, easily and accurately.

To store or change your Speed Call numbers:

1. Listen for dial tone and dial *75.
2. Dial the Speed Call number (00 through 29) you have selected and the complete telephone number it will represent (example 00 + 555-1111), then depress the # button. Remember to include the 1 + area code for long distance entries.
3. Repeat the above steps for each number to be stored.

To use a Speed Call number:

1. Listen for dial tone and press the * button.
2. Dial the appropriate two-digit speed call number and your call will be dialed automatically.

Three-way Calling

Turn an everyday phone call into a three-way conversation.

To add a third party:

1. Place the person you're talking with on hold by depressing the hook switch or flash button for about one second.
2. Listen for the dial tone. Then dial the number of the third party you wish to add to your conversation. When the third party answers, you may talk privately before completing your three-way connection.
3. When your third party is on the line, press the hook switch or flash button once to get back to your held party. Now all three parties will be on the line.

To disconnect the third party:

1. Press the hook switch or flash button for about one second. You will now have only the original party on the line.
2. If either of the other two people hang up, you can continue to talk to the remaining party.

To disconnect completely:

1. Simply hang up.

Note: If the call to the third party is not completed or if someone else answers the phone and the person you want to speak with is unavailable, depress the hook switch or flash button twice to resume your conversation with your first caller.

Calling Features / Traditional

Warm Line

Warm Line allows a person to knock the phone off the hook in any emergency, assuring them that an automatic call to a predetermined number will alert someone to their situation.

When your telephone is lifted off-hook and normal dialing has not started before the end of the time delay period, the predetermined stored number is automatically dialed by SRT's central office switching equipment.

Call SRT's Customer Service at 852-1200 to set up this service.

Create Your Personal Telephone List

Some calling features require you to create a personal telephone list. This is achieved by dialing the access code for each service to gain entry to the instructions.

These features require a personal telephone list.

- Selective Call Rejection
- Selective Call Acceptance
- Selective Call Forwarding
- Distinctive Ring Call Waiting

To Add a Private Entry:

1. Access the main menu and dial #, 01, #. This will add the last incoming call to your list, even though you don't know the telephone number. If it was previously added, the system will indicate that it is already on your list.

To Delete a Private Entry from Your List:

1. Access the main menu and dial 09.
2. All Private Entries will be deleted. You cannot selectively remove a Private Entry.

Note: Each service requires its own list. Once established, your list will remain intact, even if you don't have the feature activated. You can modify and update your list as often as you like without activating your service. Simply access the main menu and follow the prompts.

Shortcuts to use with various calling features

Shortcuts may be used with the following features: Anonymous Call Rejection, Distinctive Ring Call Waiting, Selective Call Acceptance, Selective Call Forwarding, and Selective Call Rejection.

Shortcut

Calling Features / Metaswitch Upgrade

SRT is in the process of upgrading equipment in our network that controls landline voice calls. Throughout this expected two-year process, customers will be notified of their upgrade period. The upgrade moves customers from the old telephone switch, which is the piece of equipment that allows voice calls to reach the person being called, and moves customers to the new equipment, a Metaswitch. Most customers will not notice a difference but it is important to note that some landline calling features will change. The new calling feature instructions are on the next few pages.

If you have a calling feature and aren't sure which section to refer to, you can try the Traditional section first, followed by this Metaswitch Upgrade section. Or, simply call SRT at 858-1200 and we will be happy to assist you.

Anonymous Call Rejection

You can reject incoming calls from calling parties who choose to keep their number private. The calling party will receive an announcement informing them that “the party you are trying to reach is not accepting calls from private numbers.” The calling party also hears “reverse your number privacy and try again.”

To enable Anonymous Call Rejection: Listen for dial tone and dial *77.

To disable Anonymous Call Rejection: Listen for dial tone and dial *87.

Call Forward Remote Activation

Activate and deactivate call forwarding from another telephone number. You must subscribe to Call Forwarding for this service to work.

Note: Pressing # after each entry will speed up the process.

A four-digit PIN is required for this service.

To set PIN number: This must be done from the landline telephone on which you have Call Forward Remote Activation.

META: Software is being used to randomly generate a PIN. To receive your new PIN, call SRT at 858-1200.

To change your META PIN:

1. Listen for the dial tone and dial *319.
2. You will be prompted to enter current PIN followed by the “#” sign.
3. You will be prompted to enter your new four-digit PIN.
4. You will hear, “Your PIN has been successfully changed to XXXX.” (PIN is repeated)

To activate Call Forward Remote Activation:

1. Dial the following telephone number to access the Call Forward Remote Activation line: 418-0000.
2. Enter your 10-digit phone number that has remote activation service, followed by the PIN number.
3. Dial *72 and the telephone number where you want your calls forwarded (include area code if necessary).
4. To confirm, dial 1 and hang up.

To deactivate Call Forward Remote Activation:

1. Dial the following telephone number to access the Call Forward Remote Activation line: 418-0000.
2. Enter your 10-digit phone number that has remote activation service, followed by the PIN number.
3. Press *73 and hang up.

Call Forwarding

Forward calls from your landline telephone to another phone.

To activate Call Forwarding:

1. Lift the handset, listen for dial tone and dial *72.
2. Dial the number you want your calls to be forwarded to. Speed Calling codes may be used if you have this feature.
3. Listen for a two-beep confirmation tone, indicating that call forwarding has been activated, then hang up.

To deactivate Call Forwarding:

1. Lift the handset, listen for the dial tone and dial *73.
2. Listen for a two-beep confirmation tone, indicating that call forwarding has been disabled, then hang up.

* META customers do NOT hear one short ring each time a call is forwarded.

* You can still make outgoing calls from the phone.

* To change the number your calls are forwarded to, disable the feature and set it up again.

Calling Features / Metaswitch Upgrade

Call Transfer

Transfer a call to another party and make your line available for other calls.

To enable Call Transfer:

1. With a call in progress, press the hook switch or flash button. This will put the call on hold.
2. Listen for a confirmation tone and dial the telephone number where you want to transfer the call.
3. You can announce the call or hang up and the two parties will be connected.
4. If you press the hook switch or flash again, you've established a 3-way call.

If you reach a busy signal, unanswered ringing line, or wrong number while attempting to transfer a call, press the flash button once to join the busy signal, ringing line, or wrong number with you and the original party. Press the flash button again to drop the busy signal, ringing line, or wrong number. You will remain connected to your original party.

Note: If you transfer a call out of your local service area, you will accumulate toll charges if the other two parties remain connected.

Call Waiting

While you're on a call, Call Waiting alerts you that you have another incoming call.

Note: If two calls are on a line at one time, anyone calling will receive a busy signal. A call waiting beep does not have to be answered.

Terminate either call:

1. Simply hang up. Your telephone will ring and when you answer, you will connect with the other caller. The call you discontinued will no longer be on the line.

Call Waiting Caller ID

See who's calling while you're on another call.

Note: Your phone display unit must be compatible with Call Waiting Caller ID. You must also subscribe to Call Waiting and Caller ID for this service to work.

To use Call Waiting Caller ID:

1. When you are on the phone, you will hear a distinct Call waiting tone.
2. The caller's name and/or number will show on your phone display.
3. You choose whether to answer.

Call Wake-Up/Regular Reminder Calls

Your telephone can be used as an alarm clock.

How to use:

1. Lift the handset, listen for dial tone and dial *314.
2. Listen for dial tone after voice prompt instructions, then enter the time using 24 hour military time format, followed by *.
3. Listen for dial tone after voice prompt instructions, then enter the option code that represents when the reminder call is desired, followed by #.

Option Codes:

- 1 = Monday
- 2 = Tuesday
- 3 = Wednesday
- 4 = Thursday
- 5 = Friday
- 6 = Saturday
- 7 = Sunday
- 8 = Every Weekday
- 9 = Every Day

4. Receive confirmation for which time and day(s) have been programmed. Then caller hears dial tone.
5. META does not enable customers to set the number of rings. The phone will ring until answered. When answered, the customer will hear, "This is your reminder call." Dial #317 to check existing reminders.

To Cancel a Wake-Up Call:

1. Lift the Handset, listen for a dial tone, and dial *315 to disable all reminders, or *316 to disable one reminder.

Calling Features / Metaswitch Upgrade

Caller ID Block

Prevent your name and telephone number from being displayed to the person you're calling. Choose permanent Caller ID Block or block your calls on a per-call basis.

Note: For per-call blocking you MUST dial *67 before each call you place. Otherwise, your name and telephone number will be displayed to the person receiving your call.

How to use Per-Call Blocking:

1. Listen for dial tone and dial *67.
2. Dial the number you wish to call.
3. The person you call will not be able to see your name and number displayed on their phone display screen, instead, "private" will be displayed. (not guaranteed outside local area)

To Deactivate Caller ID Block:

If you subscribe to permanent Caller ID Block and you wish to unblock your line on a per-call basis, do the following:

1. Listen for dial tone and dial *82.
2. Dial the number you wish to call.
3. The person you've called will be able to see your name and number on their phone display unit.

Caller ID Number – Caller ID Name & Number

See the telephone number or name and number of the person calling before you answer the phone. Identify annoying or harassing calls and select the calls you choose to answer.

Note: If "Private" appears on your phone display, the caller may have blocked their name and number from displaying.

If "Unknown number" or "Out of Area" appears, the caller is in an area that does not support Caller ID service.

To use Caller ID:

1. When receiving a call, wait until your telephone completes the first ring as calls are identified between the first and second rings.
2. The telephone number, or name and number, will automatically appear on your phone display.

Cancel Call Waiting

Cancel Call Waiting is when you don't want a call to be interrupted.

Note: If you activate Cancel Call Waiting, anyone calling will receive a busy signal while you are on the line.

To activate prior to making a call:

1. Lift the handset and listen for the normal dial tone.

2. Dial *70 and listen for a second dial tone. Call Waiting is disabled for the duration of the call and will automatically be turned back on when you hang up.

To activate while on a call:

1. Depress the hook switch or flash button to obtain a second dial tone.
2. Dial *70 and listen for a confirmation tone. The system will automatically re-establish the original connection. When your call is completed, hang up and call waiting is automatically restored.

Continuous Redial/Automatic Callback

Keep redialing busy numbers and be notified when the line becomes available.

Note: You may place other calls while Continuous Redial attempts to reach a busy number.

You may hear "The number you are trying to reach cannot be handled by automatic callback."

To enable Continuous Redial:

1. After calling a number and reaching a busy signal, hang up. Lift the handset again and listen for the dial tone and dial *66. You will hear a message indicating that you have activated the service. Hang up.
2. Your phone will continue to call the busy line for up to 30 minutes.
3. A distinctive callback ring alerts you when the line becomes free. When you hear the distinctive ring, lift the handset and wait for the called party to answer.

To disable Continuous Redial:

1. Listen for the dial tone and dial *86.
2. Listen for the confirmation message and hang up.

Custom Ringing

Custom Ringing allows two additional phone numbers to be assigned to a main line. A unique ring is assigned to each number. Ring patterns can be switched around.

Call SRT's Customer Service at 852-1200 to set up this service.

An example of how Custom Ring is used would include 1 main line & 3 Teen lines.

If the main telephone number is dialed, the first teen line can be set with Distinctive Ring 2, the second teen line can be set with Distinctive Ring 3, and the third teen line can be set with Distinctive Ring 4.

Calling Features / Metaswitch Upgrade

Called Party with Call Waiting Hears:

- Normal Single Beep
- 2 Short Beeps
- 3 Short Beeps
- Short Long Short Beeps

Called Party hears:

- Normal Ring
- Long Long
- Short Short Long
- Short Long Short

Customized Originated Trace

Trace harassing calls and at your request; your local law enforcement agency will investigate. This should only be used to trace life threatening calls or calls which are of a harassing nature in which you may want to press charges.

To enable Customer Originated Trace:

1. When you receive a harassing or threatening call, hang up. Immediately pick up the handset and listen for the dial tone.
2. Dial *57 and listen for a message indicating that you have successfully activated the tracing feature.
3. Hang up.
4. The number you traced will be recorded at the telecommunications provider. If you decide to follow up on the matter, you will need to work directly with your local law enforcement agency for further investigation.

Note: The traced number will only be available to your local telecommunications provider. It will be provided to local law enforcement only after a formal request is made to them. Under no circumstances are traced numbers provided directly to telephone subscribers.

Distinctive Ring Call Waiting – also known as Priority Call

Create a list of up to 10 specific telephone numbers from which calls will ring in a unique pattern. When someone on your list calls, their call will ring with a different tone. If you are on the phone and another caller from your list calls, the Call Waiting tone will differ from a regular Call Waiting beep. All other calls not included on your Distinctive Ring Call Waiting list will ring to your line as normal.

Note: You must subscribe to Call Waiting for this service to work.

Area limitations may apply when establishing your list.

To activate Distinctive Ring Call Waiting:

1. Listen for dial tone and dial *61 to access the main menu.

2. Continue following the prompts to establish your list.
3. Press 3 to turn the service on/off.

Last Call Return/Automatic Recall

Dial the last number that called you.

Note: You may hear a message stating “The number you are trying to reach cannot be handled by automatic recall.”

To enable Last Call Return:

1. Listen for dial tone and dial *69. You will hear a message describing the steps required to complete the callback.

If the line is busy:

1. You will hear a message stating the line is busy and how to proceed. Hang up and your phone will continue to place the call every minute up to 30 minutes.
2. A distinctive callback ring alerts you when the line becomes available.
3. Pick up the handset and wait for the called party to answer.

To disable Last Call Return:

1. Listen for dial tone and dial *89. You will hear a recording stating that Last Call Return is deactivated.
2. Hang up.

Selective Call Acceptance

Screen incoming calls by creating a list of up to 10 telephone numbers from which you are willing to accept calls. Calls from telephone numbers not included in your list will receive an announcement informing them that you are not accepting calls at this time.

To create your Selective Call Acceptance list:

1. Listen for the dial tone and dial *64 to access the main menu.
2. Continue following the prompts to establish your list.
3. Long distance numbers must be programmed as a “private” entry immediately after the call takes place. Listen for dial tone and dial *64 followed by #, 01, #.
4. Press 3 to turn the service on/off.

Selective Call Forwarding

Create a list of up to 10 specific telephone numbers from which calls will be forwarded to a number of your choice. When someone on the list calls, their call will ring at the forwarding number. All other calls not included on the Selective Call Forwarding list will ring to your line as usual.

To use Selective Call Forwarding:

1. Listen for dial tone and dial *63 to access the main menu.

Calling Features / Metaswitch Upgrade

2. Continue following the prompts to establish your list.
3. Press 3 to turn the service on/off.

Selective Call Rejection

Create a list of up to 20 telephone numbers from which you do not wish to receive calls. Calls from telephone numbers included in your list will receive an announcement informing them that you are not accepting calls at this time. Blocked currently accepting calls from you.”

Note: Area limitations may apply when establishing your list.

Selective Call Rejection takes precedence over Selective Call Forwarding and Anonymous Call Rejection.

To create your Selective Call Rejection List:

1. Listen for the dial tone and dial *60 to access the main menu.
2. Continue following the prompts to establish your list.
3. Long distance numbers must be programmed as a “private” entry immediately after the call takes place. Listen for dial tone and dial *60 followed by #, 01, #.
4. Press 3 to turn the service on/off.

Simultaneous Ring (SIM Ring)

Program additional telephone lines to ring at the same time with SIM Ring. For example, a call made to your home can ring your wireless phone, office phone and lake cabin all at the same time. The first one to answer accepts the call.

To enable/disable the SIM Ring service, you must use the handset that is programmed with SIM Ring.

To enable META SIM Ring, dial *361.

To disable META SIM Ring, dial *362.

PIN (Personal Identification Number) Changes for SIM Ring and Call Forward Remote Activation

This must be done from the phone line programmed with the feature(s) requiring a PIN, i.e.; Call Forward Remote Access and SIM Ring.

1. Listen for dial tone and dial *319 to access the main menu.
2. The voice prompt will say “Please enter your current PIN followed by the number sign key” - Enter current PIN using key pad and #.
3. The voice prompt will say, “Please enter your new four-digit PIN followed by the number sign key.” Enter new four-digit PIN using key pad and #.

4. Automated voice will provide a confirmation message stating the new four-digit PIN. This message is played twice.

Speed Call 8

Call your 8 most frequently dialed numbers quickly, easily and accurately.

To store or change your Speed Call Numbers:

1. Listen for dial tone and dial *74.
2. Dial the Speed Call Number (2 through 9) you have selected and the complete telephone number it will represent (example: 2 + 555 +1111), then press the # button. Remember to include the 1+ area code for long distance entries.
3. Repeat the above steps for each number to be stored.

To use a Speed Call 8 Number:

1. Listen for a dial tone and dial the 1-digit number (2 through 9) that represents the stored phone number.

Speed Call 30

Call your 30 most frequently dialed numbers quickly, easily, and accurately.

To store or change your Speed Call Numbers:

1. Listen for dial tone and dial *75.
2. Dial the Speed Call Number (20 through 49) you have selected and the complete telephone number it will represent (example: 20 + 555 + 1111), then press the # button. Remember to include the 1+ area code for long distance entries.
3. Repeat the above steps for each number to be stored.

To use a Speed Call 30 Number:

1. Listen for a dial tone and dial the 2-digit number (20 through 49) that represents the stored phone number.

Calling Features / Metaswitch Upgrade

Three-way Calling

Turn an everyday phone call into a three-way conversation.

To add a third party:

1. Place the person you're talking with on hold by depressing the hook switch or flash button for about one second.
2. Listen for the dial tone. Then dial the number of the third party you wish to add to your conversation. When the third party answers, you may talk privately before completing your three-way connection.
3. When your third party is on the line, press the hook switch or flash button once to get back to your held party. Now all three parties will be on the line.

To disconnect the third party:

1. Press the hook switch or flash button for about one second. You will now have only the original party on the line.
2. If either of the other two people hang up, you can continue to talk to the remaining party.

To disconnect completely:

1. Simply hang up.

Note: If the call to the third party is not completed or if someone else answers the phone and the person you want to speak with is unavailable, depress the hook switch or flash button twice to resume your conversation with your first caller.

Warm Line

Warm Line allows a person to knock the phone off the hook in any emergency, assuring them that an automatic call to a predetermined number will alert someone to their situation.

When your telephone is lifted off-hook and normal dialing has not started before the end of the time delay period, the predetermined stored number is automatically dialed by SRT's central office switching equipment.

Call SRT's Customer Service at 852-1200 to set up this service.

Create Your Personal Telephone List

Some calling features require you to create a personal telephone list. This is achieved by dialing the access code for each service to gain entry to the instructions.

These features require a personal telephone list.

- Selective Call Rejection
- Selective Call Acceptance
- Selective Call Forwarding
- Distinctive Ring Call Waiting

To Add a Private Entry:

1. Access the main menu and dial #, 01, #. This will add the last incoming call to your list, even though you don't know the telephone number. If it was previously added, the system will indicate that it is already on your list.

To Delete a Private Entry from Your List:

1. Access the main menu and dial 09.
2. All Private Entries will be deleted. You cannot selectively remove a Private Entry.

Note: Each service requires its own list. Once established, your list will remain intact, even if you don't have the feature activated. You can modify and update your list as often as you like without activating your service. Simply access the main menu and follow the prompts.

Shortcuts to use with various calling features

Shortcuts may be used with the following features: Anonymous Call Rejection, Distinctive Ring Call Waiting, Selective Call Acceptance, Selective Call Forwarding, and Selective Call Rejection.

Consumer Guidelines

Allowance for Failure of Service

SRT DOES NOT GUARANTEE UNINTERRUPTED WORKING OF ITS LINES OR EQUIPMENT. In case service is interrupted, any adjustments made shall apply only to the period beyond twenty-four (24) hours after notice is received by SRT. No other liability shall in any case attach to SRT. Request for adjustment on bills must be made within 45 days from period of trouble, interruption or billing question.

Annoyance/Threatening Calls

Intentional annoyance of any person by use of the telephone is prohibited by law. It is against the law to use the telephone to threaten to inflict harm on any person, to any persons reputation, or to any property.

Consumer Rights

If you have a problem SRT has not corrected to your satisfaction, you have the right to file a formal or informal complaint with the North Dakota Public Service Commission. Their address and phone number is:

The consumer also has certain rights and obligations concerning the use and payment of pay-per-call services. SRT is prohibited against disconnection of basic communication services for the failure to pay pay-per-call charges established by the FCC (Federal Communications Commission) Regulation 64.1507, the right of a subscriber to obtain blocking in accordance with FCC Regulation 64.1508, the right of a subscriber not to be billed for pay-per-call services not offered in compliance with federal laws and regulations established by FCC Regulation 64.1510 (a) (iv), and the possibility that a subscriber's access to 900 services may be involuntarily blocked pursuant to FCC Regulation 64.1512 for failure to pay legitimate pay-per-call charges.

Deposit Policy

Customers may be asked to pay a deposit to establish telephone service. The amount of deposit is determined during the application process.

Directory Listings

The vast majority of all directory listings are correct. But, as with any job of this size, the possibility for errors does occur. If your listing in the directory is incorrect, it cannot be changed until the next edition of the directory is issued. SRT does not guarantee the correctness nor completeness of the

listings in the telephone directory, which includes the white pages, yellow pages, blue pages and other advertisements. SRT's liability for errors is limited. SRT's limited liability is set forth in its tariff on file with the North Dakota Public Service Commission.

Employee Identification

SRT technicians wear SRT logo'd clothing and drive SRT marked vehicles when they are working. We also employ contractors who may have any combination of their company logo on clothing, company vehicle, SRT Contractor marked vehicle, or SRT Contractor ID card. If you have questions regarding a person's SRT employment please ask to see their identification or call our office for verification.

Fraud

It is unlawful in North Dakota to make, possess, sell, give or otherwise transfer any device that can be adapted to obtain free telecommunication services. The advertising of such devices and instructions for making or assembling the devices is also illegal. Fraudulent use of a calling card or telephone billing number in an attempt to obtain telecommunications service and avoid charges is prohibited by law.

Lightning

During a lightning storm, use your own discretion when using the telephone because it could result in injury or death. Your telephone company assumes no liability of any accident or injury due to the use of your telephone during a lightning storm.

Ownership and Use of Equipment

Equipment, instruments and lines furnished by SRT on the premises of a subscriber up to the demark point are the property of SRT. In order to protect its service SRT reserves the right to remove all unauthorized appliances, instruments, or the like attached to its facilities. The company's agents and employees shall have the right to enter said premises at any reasonable hour for purposes of installing, inspecting, maintaining, or repairing the equipment.

Consumer Guidelines

Relay North Dakota - Dial 711

Relay North Dakota is a free service that provides full telephone accessibility to people who are deaf, hard-of-hearing, deaf-blind, and speech-disabled. This service allows hearing callers to communicate with text-telephone (TTY) users and vice versa through specially trained Communication Assistants (CAs). Calls can be made to anywhere in the world, 24 hours a day, 365 days a year with no restrictions on the number, length, or type of calls. All calls are strictly confidential and no records of any conversations are maintained. Anyone wishing to use Relay North Dakota simply dials the relay number to connect with a CA. The CA will dial the requested number and relay the conversation between the two callers.

Subscriber Responsibility of Telephone

Telephone instruments are for the use of subscribers, their families and employees only. The subscriber is requested not to permit any other person, firm or corporation the use of the same (especially to advertise same) without permission of SRT. As set forth in SRT's tariff on file with the North Dakota Public Service Commission, SRT is not liable for any toll fraud. All ordinary expense or maintenance and repair, unless otherwise specified in SRT tariffs or in the contract for the use of the equipment, will be assumed by SRT. In case of damage to or destruction of any equipment due to negligence of the subscriber, the subscriber shall pay the cost of restoring the equipment to its original condition.

Tariff, General Rules and Regulations

Rates applicable to the furnishing of the various services by SRT are contained in tariffs on file in the business office. The tariff is the agreement governing the relationship between SRT and its customers. Our service representatives will be glad to assist you in obtaining information from them.

Do Not Call List

Register with the State and National Do Not Call Telemarketing List

Are you fed up with having your evenings interrupted by calls from telemarketers? Now you can do something about it.

You can stop almost all telemarketing calls by registering on the North Dakota Attorney General's "Do Not Call" list.

Registering is free and easy!

- Register your HOME and CELL PHONE numbers.
- Your numbers will stay on the list until you remove them.
- You only need to register a number once for it to be included on both the state list and the national do not call list.
- The "Do Not Call" law took effect on August 1, 2003. It is a violation for a telemarketer to call you more than 30 days after you have registered on the list.

Note: you only need to register a number once for it to be included on both the state list and the national do not call list.

Use of Residence Telephones for Business Purposes

Residence telephones are installed with the understanding that they will be used for normal social or domestic purposes.

A residence telephone will be considered a business if the subscriber chooses to have a business listing in the telephone directory or the service is located in a commercially zoned area.

Wiretapping

It is a crime under federal and state laws for any person to wiretap or otherwise intercept a telephone call, unless that person has first obtained the consent of one or both of the parties actually participating in the call. Properly authorized law enforcement officers can take part in interceptions without the consent of either party, when proceeding under court orders issued following the appropriate federal or state law.

Lifeline and Link-up

What is Lifeline?

Lifeline is a government benefit program supported by the Universal Service Fund that provides a discount on voice or broadband service for qualifying low-income consumers. Lifeline helps ensure that eligible consumers have the opportunities and security that these services bring, including being able to connect to jobs, family, and emergency services. Federal Lifeline support in the amount of \$9.25 per month will be made available to qualifying low-income consumers.

Qualifying for Lifeline Support

A consumer of SRT Communications or North Dakota Network Co. (doing business as SRT Wireless), must either have a household income that is at or below 135% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines, or participate in one of the following assistance programs:

- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Medicaid
- Federal Public Housing Assistance
- Veterans Pension and Survivors Benefit Program

If you are requesting Lifeline on the basis of your household income, please refer to the Estimated Income Requirements for a Household at or below the Federal Poverty Guidelines. You may find this chart, which is revised annually, on the United States Department of Health and Human Services, website at <https://aspe.hhs.gov/poverty-guidelines>.

Important Notes for Eligible Consumers Nationwide

- Lifeline is available for wireline voice or broadband; or wireless voice or broadband services, however only one discount per household is allowed.
- Lifeline is a government benefit program, and consumers who willfully make false statements in order to obtain the benefit can be punished by fine or imprisonment or can be barred from the program.

Qualifying for Enhanced Lifeline and Link-Up Support on Tribal Lands

A consumer living on tribal lands may be eligible for enhanced Lifeline and Link-Up if he/she has an income at or below 135% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines, participates in any of the qualifying assistance programs for regular Lifeline and

Link-Up, or participates in any of these additional qualifying assistance programs for Enhanced Lifeline and Link-Up:

Tribal-Specific Programs

- Bureau of Indian Affairs General Assistance
- Tribally-Administered Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TTANF)
- Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPIR)
- Head Start (only households that meet the income qualifying standard)

Important Notes for Eligible Consumers Living on Tribal Lands

- Link-Up provides eligible low-income consumers living on Tribal lands with a one-time discount of up to \$100 on the initial installation or activation of a wireline or wireless voice or broadband service.
- Federal Lifeline support in the amount of \$9.25 per month will be made available to qualifying low-income consumers. Additional federal Lifeline support of up to \$25 per month will be made available to eligible residents of Tribal lands. The total Lifeline support cannot exceed the Residential Local Line Charge.

How Can I Sign Up?

To apply for Lifeline or enhanced Lifeline and Link-Up, call SRT Communications or North Dakota Network Company (doing business as SRT Wireless) at 701-858-1200 or 1-800-737-9130. Lifeline Assistance Application forms for SRT Communications, Inc. and North Dakota Network Co. (dba SRT Wireless) are available at www.srt.com. By completing this application, you are certifying that all Lifeline qualification requirements are met. Application forms can be mailed to P.O. Box 2027, Minot, ND 58702-2027. Upon receipt of the application form, SRT or SRT Wireless may require additional documentation.

For more details, contact the FCC at 1-888-225-5322 voice, 1-888-835-5322 TTY, or by mail at FCC, 445 12th ST SW, Washington, DC 20554. You may also visit the FCC's website at www.lifeline.gov.

FCC regulations state that broadband Lifeline must remain with the same internet service provider for at least 12 months or the same telephone provider for 60 days after first qualifying for the Lifeline discount. After that, you are free to switch your internet or phone service and qualify for a Lifeline benefit with a different company. The FCC allows an exception if you move to a different state or area where your provider doesn't offer service.

Calls to Canada, Puerto Rico, the U.S. Virgin Islands and Most Dial Points in the Caribbean/Atlantic Region

These calls can be dialed the same as long distance calls within the Continental United States.

Toll Restriction

If long distance charges have gotten out of hand, there is a solution. SRT can restrict your telephone line and long distance dialing would be prevented for the time you requested. For more information contact your customer service representative today.

Wrong Numbers

When you dial long distance and reach a wrong number, keep track of the call and when it is billed, call your long distance carrier for credit.

Collect Calls

- 800-CALLATT (charges will be billed to you by AT&T)
- 800-COLLECT (charges will be billed to you by MCI)

International Dialing Instructions

All SRT exchanges have international dialing capabilities.

To place an international call, dial:

For example: To place a direct dialed call to Oslo, Norway, you would dial:

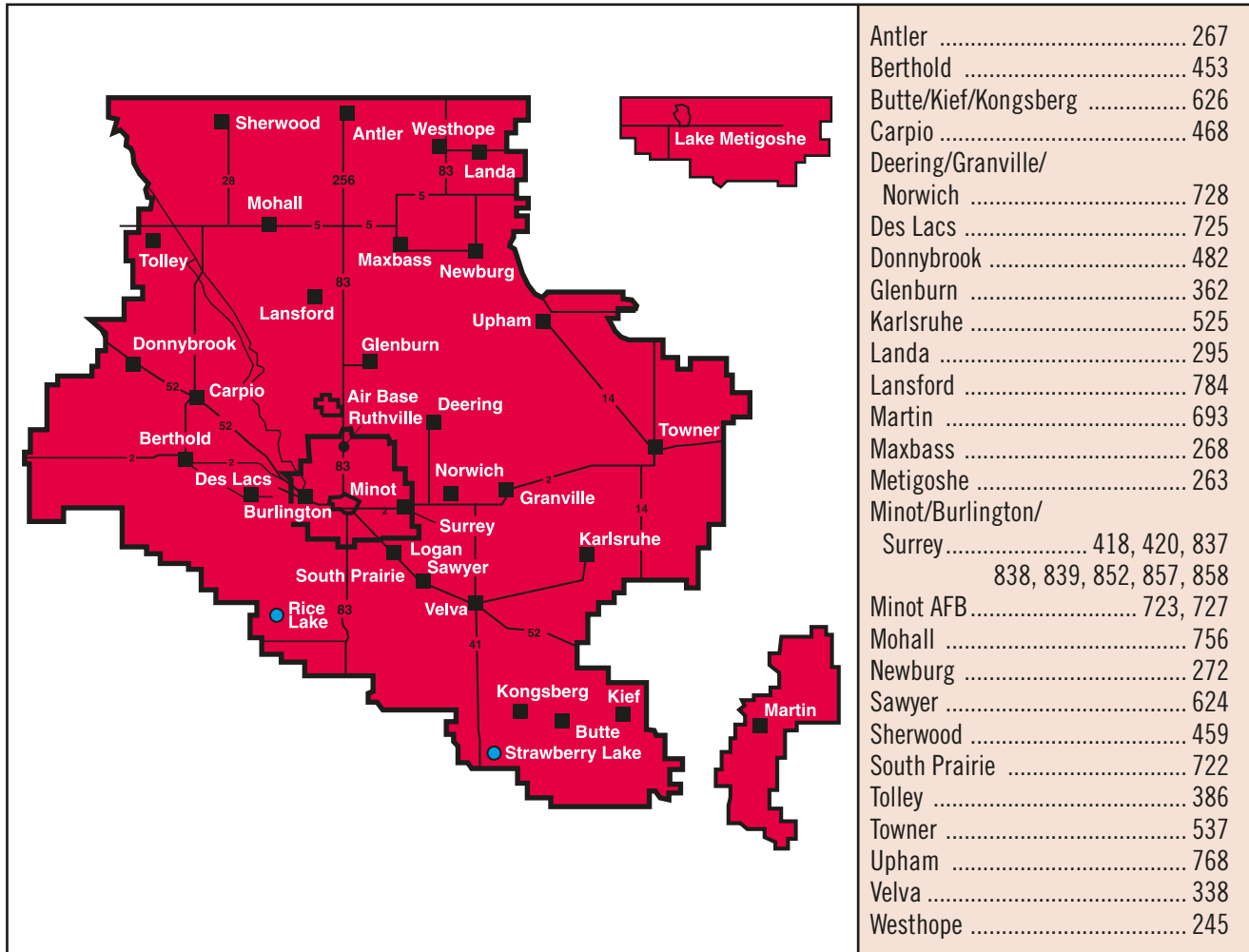
