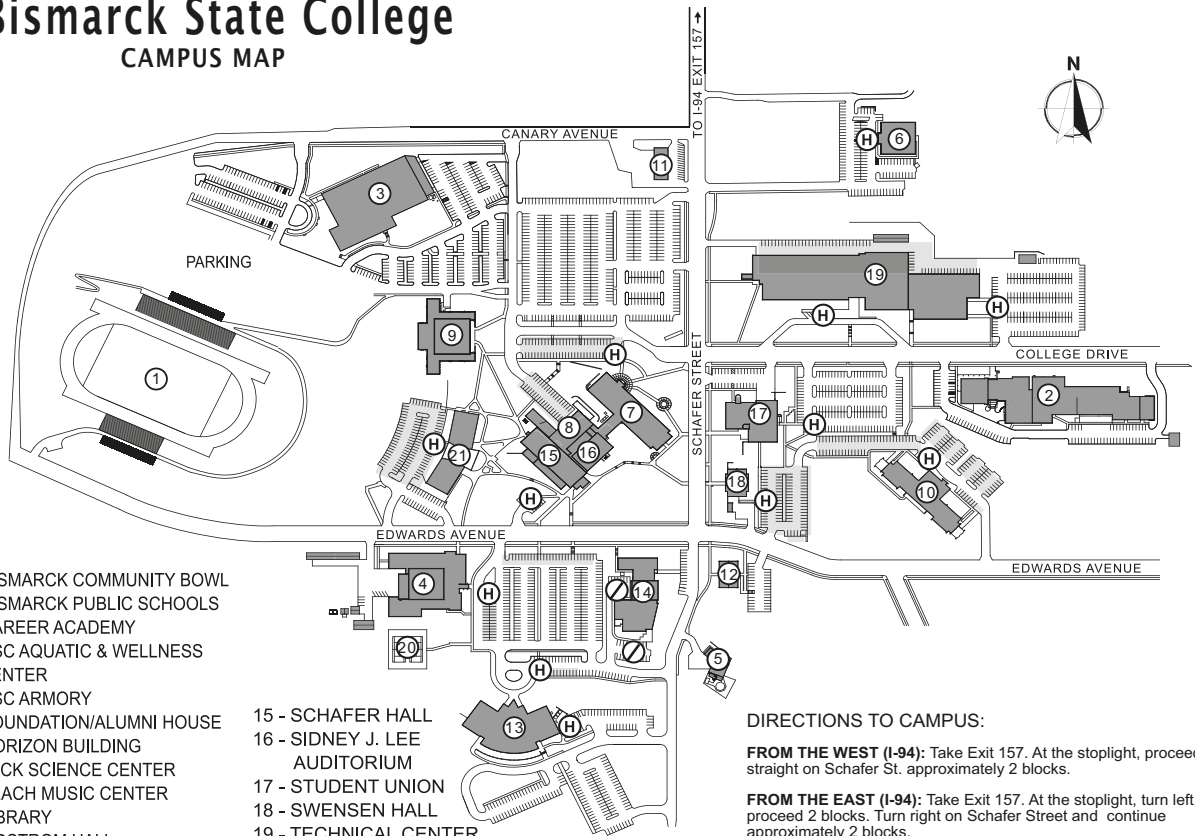

As a community service, Sitting Bull College has coordinated public transit since 1989. The Transportation Program currently operates Inter-city, Dial-A-Ride, Inter-state, and Veteran hospital services.

Eleven Inter-city routes are provided Monday through Friday for Mobridge, Wakpala, Kenel, Little Eagle, Bullhead, Bear Soldier South and McLaughlin in South Dakota and Fort Yates, Porcupine, Selfridge, Cannonball, Solen, Prairie Knights Casino, and Bismarck/Mandan in North Dakota. Each Inter-city route connects passengers to fixed route and Dial-A-Ride services in Bismarck and Mandan, North Dakota. Other Dial-A-Ride services are provided Monday through Friday in Fort Yates, ND and Mobridge, SD.

Inter-state services are available each Monday and Thursday to and from national charter bus services in Bismarck, ND, and Pierre, Rapid City and Sioux Falls, SD.

Twice monthly routes are available to the North and South Dakota Veteran's hospitals in Fargo, ND and Sturgis, SD.

Anyone can ride any of the transit routes regardless of their status. The Standing Rock Public Transportation Program is locally funded by Sitting Bull College and the Standing Rock Sioux Tribe.

## Birding Drives

Along each of the three area driving routes, you will be rewarded with a bounty of opportunities to observe, study and photograph interesting birds amid historic landscapes in the Northern Great Plains.

Visit: [www.discoverbismarckmandan.com](http://www.discoverbismarckmandan.com) and click on "outdoor adventures" to view the drives. You can also stop by the Visitor Center at 1600 Burnt Boat Drive in Bismarck to pick up a brochure.

### The Missouri River Route

leads you north from Bismarck along the east side of the Missouri River floodplain and meanders along the buttes of the Missouri Breaks, where you will find an interesting variety of birds that inhabit the forested riverbottoms and the neighboring prairie hills. Painted Woods Lake provides a look at wetland birds, and provides a pleasant hiking route. Just north of the town of Washburn you can access the river woodlands at Fort Mandan. From there, you cross the mighty Missouri and follow the west side of the valley, which is a bit more rugged and includes stops at two exceptional natural areas - the Cross Ranch State Park and Smith Grove, an ancient forest, where you can walk among 200 year old cottonwood trees - before returning to the city of Mandan.



### The McKenzie Route

leads you east of Bismarck to a series of very productive wetlands that attract an exciting assortment of waterfowl, shorebirds, and other species, including McKenzie Slough and Long Lake National Wildlife Refuge, which are both exceptional locations to photograph birds and other wildlife. The return route directs you back along the Missouri River Valley south of Bismarck, where you can access forested bottomlands, the riverbanks, and sandbars at McLean Bottoms and Kimball Bottoms, where Lewis and Clark saw their first plains grizzly bear.

### Little Heart Route

leads you south of Mandan, past historic Fort Abraham Lincoln to the wild Oahe woods at the Little Heart Bottoms and Sugarloaf Bottoms. Just south of Sugarloaf you pass through a corridor of Badlands formations before scaling the wooded bluffs of the Huff Hills. A backroad drive leads west to Highway 6, which will return you to Mandan, perhaps with a stop at the Morton County Wildlife Area and one last stop at the Mandan Research Station, just before you re-cross the Heart River to enter Mandan.

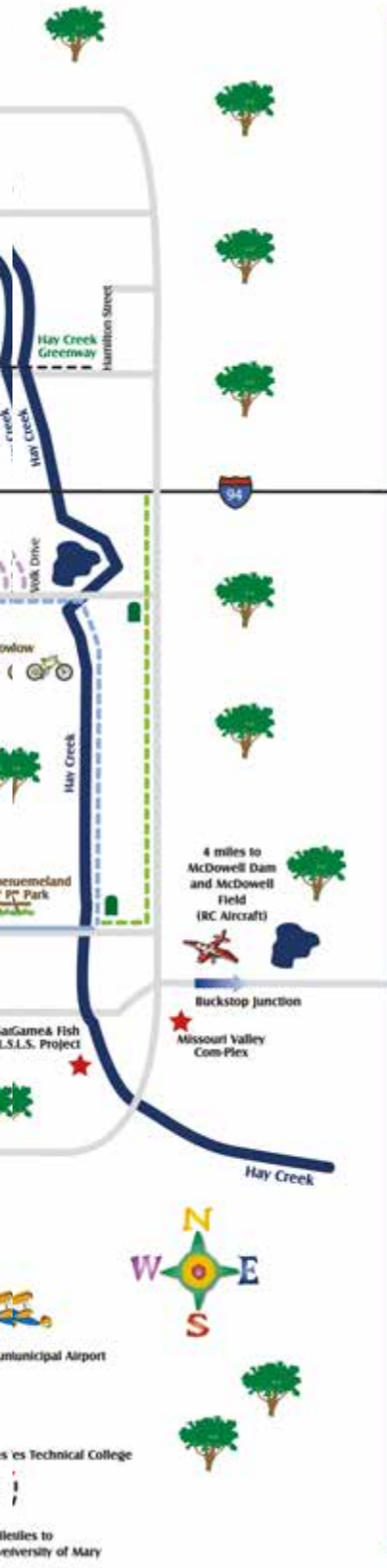

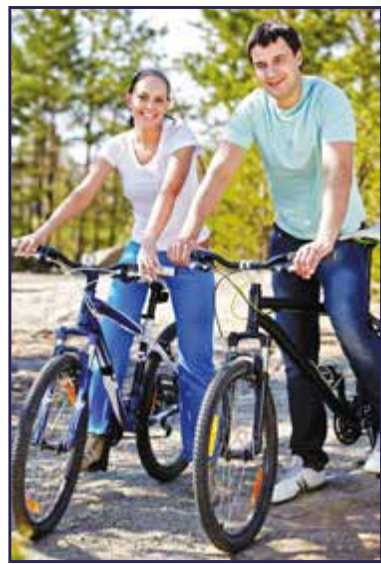
